### **General Care Instructions**

#### 1) CLEANING

- $\Rightarrow$  Clean carefully after use using a damp soft cloth to clean handles and blades ensuring you clean away from the sharp edges (NOT INTO THEM). Mind your fingers
- $\Rightarrow$  Then dry using another cloth if required
- 2) Ensure they are closed after use See below for instructions
- 3) Oil cutting mechanism and blade from time to time
- 4) STORE IN A SECURE, SAFE PLACE
- 5) If the blade gets stuck in a branch, open the handles, gently move the loppers so the blade moves up and down. DO NOT Twist the loppers/blade to release.
- 6) Check bolts/nuts for tightness from time to time

#### Note:

These are capable of cutting up to 6cm branches. The handles will open wide for 6cm cuts.

### Opening

- 1) Remove plastic sleeve
- Release lock latch by squeezing the handles together a little and moving the lock downwards towards the handles (NOT upwards towards cutting mechanism)
- 3) The lock latch can be removed if required
- 4) **NOTE**: The latch is not designed to be a secure lock.



### **Closing Instructions**

#### Closing In Ratchet Mode (Button in ON position)

- 1) Open and close handles (as if you were cutting something) until blade is closed.
- 2) This allows the ratchet mechanism to engage and keep the loppers closed
- 3) Put the plastic cover over the blades and move latch in to place
- 4) Store in a dry, safe place

#### Closing In Single Cut Mode (Button in Off position

- 1) Close handles
- 2) Put the plastic cover over the blades and move latch in to place
- 3) Store in a dry, safe place



# 2 Cutting Modes In 1 Lopper

1)Close Handles
2)Press and Move the button
ON for Ratchet Mode or
OFF for One Cut Mode



#### **Button ON = RATCHET MODE**

✓ Cuts Up To 60mm

## Using In 'Ratchet' mode - Max 60mm Cut

Using a lopper with a Ratchet Mechanism is very simple and it adds power to your hands.

If you are used to using a non ratchet lopper then it may take just a few cuts to get used to the mechanism. But there is nothing to worry about as this is normal.

1) Move red button to On and then open the loppers.





- 3) Now the 1st stage of the ratchet mechanism is engaged.
- 4) You can now close the handles, fully again and cut.
- 5) Continue repeating stage 2 and 3 until the branch is fully cut



### **Ratchet Mode Closing Instructions**

- 1) Open and close handles (as if you were cutting something) until blade is closed.
- 2) This allows the ratchet mechanism to engage and keep the loppers closed
- 3) Put the plastic cover over the blades
- 4) Store in a dry, safe place

### Using In 'Single One Cut ' mode - Max 30mm Cut

Single, one cut, mode is great for branches up to 30mm when ratchet mode is not required. The advanced compound cutting action is used here, when you move button to 'Off'

- 1) With the loppers closed, move red button to Off position and then open the loppers.
- 2) The blades will be set to open for max. 3cm diameter branches
- 3) The cutting mechanism will be set to advanced compound cutting action
- 4) Cut the branch in one squeeze of the handles

#### Warranty

- 1) We offer a 5 year guarantee against any manufacturing defects
