Charitable Choice is Hong Kong's goto charity platform powering online giving. Established in 2011, Charitable Choice is committed to support pressing social needs in Hong Kong by empowering individual and organisational philanthropy via an innovative, interactive, and trusted digital platform.

Partnering with 60+ local charity partners, users can choose to send charity eCards, make single or monthly donations, set-up fundraising campaigns, and create staff and client engagement initiatives. Our dedicated kids' portal, Charity Hero, actively engages and educates children to nurture charitable behaviours.

Charitable Choice is a registered taxexempt charitable organisation under Section 88 of the Hong Kong Inland Revenue Ordinance (Ref. 91/11221) and all donations made via the online giving platform are tax deductible in Hong Kong.

Happy 10th Birthday Charitable Choice!



To celebrate our 10th anniversary, the Board of Directors set a goal to end the year on a fundraising high of HK\$2 million for our charity partners. When we issued the call to action in October 2021, we had raised HK\$1,586,956 for the underprivileged in the community, HK\$413,044 short of our goal.

The community was urged to help us reach this impactful milestone by making a donation, buying a charity gift card or starting a fundraiser for a charity of their choice on the Charitable Choice platform before 31 December.

With the generous support of our community we reached our goal of raising HK\$2 million for local charities in 2021! In fact, we raised HK\$2,349,576, representing a record high in annual funds raised and the perfect celebration of our Charitable Choice 10th Anniversary.

Feeding Hong Kong

Food bank Feeding Hong Kong continued to provide food assistance to people in need despite a series of severe disruptions to their regular channels of food, funds and friends. By reaching out to individuals and corporates for financial support, they were able to rescue 726 tonnes of food and support a record 3 million meals for vulnerable families and individuals. Feeding Hong Kong was in the top spot this year for donations received via the Charitable Choice platform.

As we raise our little ones, we want them to learn important life lessons including generosity, empathy and responding to the needs of others.



Charity Giving Insights 2021



One-off and Monthly Donations 32.58%






DONOR PROFILE

Females continued to lead their male counterparts in online giving, accounting for over 64% of Charitable Choice users, a 2% increase from 2020/21.

In addition 25 - 34 year olds were the most active age group, making up 36% of total users.




Individual donations on the Charitable Choice platform continue to be the main driver of donations, although this year's 92%, is a little lower than the 2020/21 figure of 93%.


DEVICES USED

MFMW is engaged in crisis intervention and prevention for over 5000 migrants each year through their wide range of services and advocacy.




Feeding Hong Kong

Covid-19

Covid-19 continued to make its negative impact felt globally in 2021 and for Hong Kong, this impact really hit home in the first quarter of 2022 as the city was thrown into the fifth, and worst, wave of the pandemic to date.

Charities found themselves grappling to operate under the harshest city-wide social constraints and the continued challenges to traditional fundraising activities left many charities struggling to provide services and support to their beneficiaries.

The Charitable Choice team reached out to our charity partners to compile a list of urgent needs. Some listed protective equipment such as gowns, masks and rapid antigen tests, others required funds to purchase emergency supplies for families forced to quarantine at home without easy access to food and other necessities.

We are pleased to report that several donors within our network responded to this call to action by providing goods in kind, helping charities source much-need items at low cost or by making a financial donation.

At the time of publishing, the daily infection numbers in Hong Kong have fallen to triple-digits daily, there is a roadmap (albeit changeable) towards relaxed social constraints and eventual opening up of Hong Kong.

Festive Promotions

The festive season is one of the most generous times of the year. Charitable Choice sold 4,930 cookies and over \$73,000 worth of printed charity gift cards.



Fortune Cookies

Partnering with a local boutique bakery to provide freshly baked fortune cookies with customised fortunes inside, proceeds from the sale of these delectable cookies went towards hosting the Charitable Choice platform in the coming year.

Printed Gift Cards

We provided a limited-time-only printed Charity Gift Card offer during the Christmas season. Buyers could choose from our gorgeous collection or design their own gift cards for distribution to friends, family and colleagues.





CNY Red Packets

We also offered a limited-time-only printed charity gift card and accompanying red packet envelope during Chinese New Year. Thanks to our volunteer Bertha Sun, we were able to offer some tigerific designs!
