



DIRECTIONS: The weather has warmed up and it is time for spring cleaning! Below is a checklist of over 40 kid-friendly tasks to help get your home refreshed.

Entry

- Empty out coat closet: take out seasonal items. Donate unneeded items.



Kitchen

- For each cabinet or drawer: remove items, wipe out drawer, place items back neatly. Donate unneeded items.
- Check food expiration dates.
- Clean and organize pantry.
- Empty, clean, and organize fridge.
- Shake crumbs out of the toaster.
- Wipe down any other counter appliances.
- Wash counters and back splash.
- Clean sink.
- Shine sink faucet.
- Wash cabinet doors and knobs.

Bathrooms

- Wash outside of cabinets and vanities.
- Clean sink.
- Shine faucets.



Dining Room

- Wipe down table and chairs.
- Pick spring flowers to display in a vase on the table.

Laundry Room

- Wash laundry sink.
- Shine faucet.
- Wash lint trap with soap and water, let air dry thoroughly.



Living Room/Family Room

- Vacuum sofas. Play leap frog on pillows.
- Launder throw pillows and blankets.
- Clean lamps and lampshades.
- Sort through books, magazines, and media.
- Donate unneeded items.
- Wash hard toys with warm soapy water. Rinse and dry.
- Launder stuffed toys. Donate the toys you have outgrown.

Bedrooms

- For each drawer: remove items and wash drawer. Replace items neatly. Donate clothing that you have outgrown.
- Move bed. Sort and put away anything that was under bed—oh the treasures!
- Sweep or vacuum under the bed.
- Sprinkle mattress with baking soda, let it sit briefly. Vacuum it up.
- Launder bedding, pillows, and duvet

Garage

- Sweep garage
- Sort through toys and sports gear. Donate the toys you have outgrown.



All rooms

- Open windows.
- Dust shelves, furniture, and decor.
- Sweep, scrub or vacuum floors.
- Wash curtains.
- Wash door knobs.
- Wash switch plates.
- Wash wall trim.
- Wash windows and window sills.
