

TERM 3 : WEEK 1

Picture Study Lesson

Lesson Setup:

This term we will be studying the artworks of the Italian Renaissance painter and architect called **Raphael**. He was born in 1483 in the walled Italian city of Urbino. Raphael was often asked by the Roman Catholic Pope to paint frescoes in the Vatican or in Rome. A fresco is a large painting done on a freshly plastered wall or ceiling.

Ask your children to find the city of Urbino on a map of Italy and to add the picture of Raphael from the Appendix to their timeline or Book of Centuries.

Picture Study:

Children to closely study the fresco painting ***Disputation of the Most Holy Sacrament*** on page 35 for about 3 minutes. Then take the painting away.

Narration:

Ask your children to describe what they saw in the fresco. Ask them what story they think the artist was trying to tell.

Discussion:

Place the painting in front of your children again. Explain that the name of the painting is ***Disputation of the Most Holy Sacrament***. The fresco was completed in 1511 and is one of four frescoes in the Hall of Signatures in the Vatican. It is quite large at 5 metres high and 7.7 metres wide. Ask your children if they have anything further they want to discuss about the painting.

TERM 3 : WEEK 2

Picture Study Lesson

Review:

Ask your children if they can remember the name of the artist we are studying this term and the name of the painting studied last week.

Lesson Setup:

Today we are going to study ***Disputation of the Most Holy Sacrament*** painting again and draw its main lines. Raphael, together with Leonardo da Vinci and Michelangelo, form the trinity of great masters of the Renaissance period. They even had three Ninja Turtles named after them!

Picture Study:

Children to closely study the painting ***Disputation of the Most Holy Sacrament*** again for a few minutes. Ask your child why you think Raphael was considered a great master based on this artwork.

Draw main lines:

Ask children to draw the main lines of the painting with pencil and paper.
