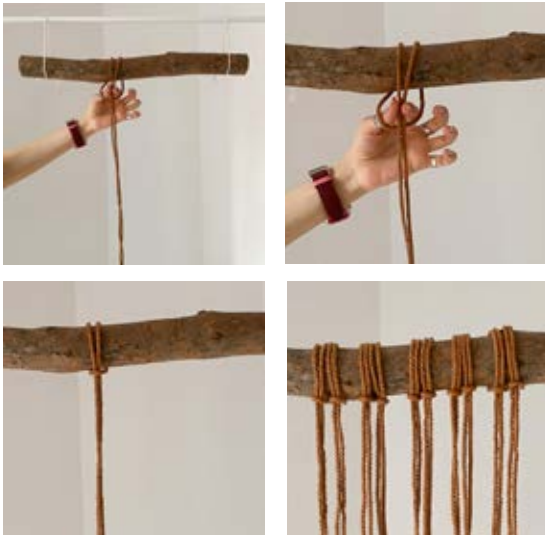
Wall Hanging Macrame

KNOTS USED

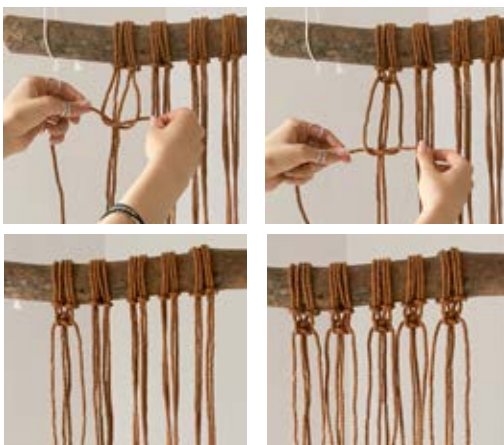
Lark head knot
Square knot
Half-sitch knot
Gathering knot

STEP BY STEP:

STEP 1: Cut the macrame cord into 10 lengths of rope that are 1,80m long. After that, we fold all of the macrame cords in half and use a lark's head knot to attach the cords to the wooden dowel.



STEP 2: With each group of 4 ropes we make a square knot. We make 5 **square knots** in this first row.



STEP 3: For the second row, we keep two ropes on the right and two ropes on the left apart and again make groups of 4 ropes to make square knots. This row has 4 square knots.



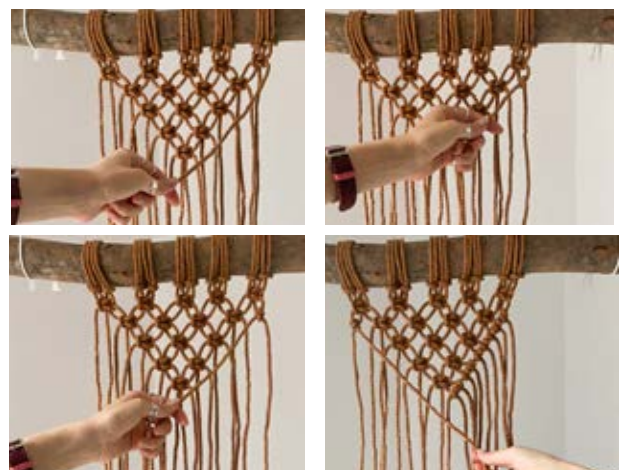
STEP 4: For the next row, keep two more ropes on the right and two ropes on the left apart and make groups of 4 ropes again to make square knots. This row has 3 square knots.



STEP 5: For the next rows, leave two more ropes apart and continue making square knots. The 4th row has 2 square knots, and the 5th row has 1 square knot.



STEP 6: Grab the rope on the right, this will be our lead cord. We work a **doublé half-hitch knot** diagonally on this lead cord with the 9 next cords.



STEP 7: Do the same for the other side. This time on the 10 cords to the right, ending on the cord that was the lead cord in step 6.



STEP 8: Cut the macrame cord into 4 lengths of rope that are 3m long. Then, fold all of the macrame cords and use a lark's head knot to attach the cords to the wooden dowel: two cords to the right, and two cords to the left of the finished part. On each side there are two central ropes of 1m and two outer ropes of 2m.



STEP 9: Take the right 4 cords and make a left-facing spiral stitch (also called a half knot sinnet) by tying 30 half knots.



STEP 10: Do the same for the other side with a right-facing spiral stitch by tying 30 half knots.



STEP 11: Take the two spirals (8 strings) and make a braid with three intertwined groups of strings. We finish at the end with a gathering knot using new piece of rope that's 1m.



STEP 12: Unravel the rope's ends, with the help of the comb, brush them and cut them in the form of a "V". Cut a piece of rope that's 1m. Tie each end of the cord to the two sides of the wooden dowel to hang our macrame project.

WASHING ADVICE

Always wash in as warm a water temperature as possible - up to the temperature recommended, with a short spin. Use a lot of water if hand washing. For darker colours we recommend the use of discolouration sheets. Do not bleach. Do not tumble dry. Drip-dry on a horizontal surface. Iron on a hot temperature setting using a damp cloth. Professional dry cleaning in tetrachloroethylene.
