



## CUSTOM BOW EQUIPMENT

### V-BAR/SIDE BAR MOUNT INSTRUCTIONS

#### STABILIZER MOUNTING

1. Using the 5/16"-24 x 7/8" screw, attach your side bar/v-bar mount to the rear stabilizer mounting hole.



2. Using the laser markings, set the top knuckle(s) to the desired position, and tighten to lock in place.



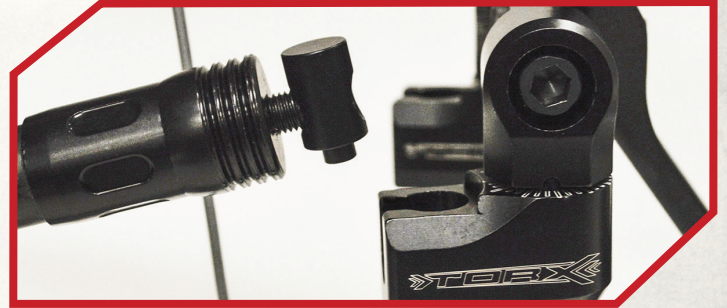
3. Using the laser markings, set the bottom knuckle(s) to the desired position, and tighten to lock in place.



4. Attach your stabilizer side bar(s) to the quick disconnect nut(s).



5. Place the quick disconnect nut(s) into the bottom knuckle(s).



6. Tighten stabilizer(s) to the bottom knuckle(s).



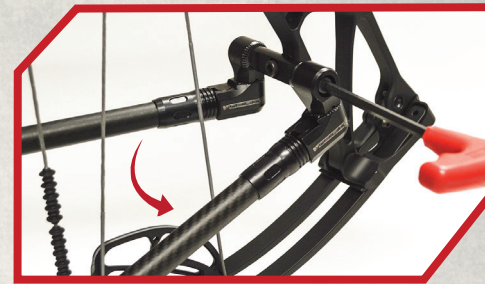
7. Your stabilizer side bar/v-bar mount is now ready for use!

## REMOVAL/ADJUSTMENT

1. Loosen ONE Knuckle at a time during adjustment/removal.
2. WHILE ATTACHED TO THE BOW, back out the screw for the desired knuckle.
3. With your stabilizer ATTACHED, rotate the stabilizer counter-clockwise until loose.

## TOP KNUCKLE ADJUSTMENT:



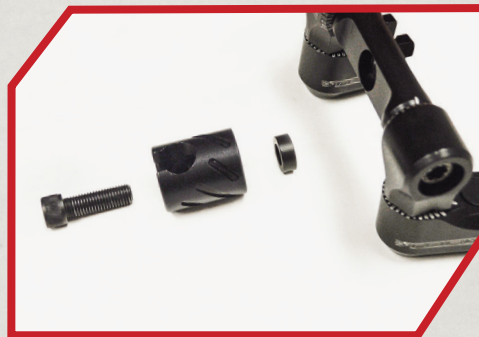

## FRONT STABILIZER MOUNTING, FRONT BAR/QUICK DISCONNECT

### WITH QUICK DISCONNECT

1. Using the provided steel insert, place the insert into the riser bracket slot before attaching front bar/quick disconnect.
2. Place the riser bracket up to the bow, and placing the insert into the slot, tighten down your front bar stabilizer to the bracket to lock your riser bracket in place.
3. Repeat steps for installation.



### WITHOUT QUICK DISCONNECT

1. Take the provided eye bolt and place it through the steel insert.
2. Using a 1/4" hex, place through the side hole in the eye bolt to tighten your front stabilizer into the threaded portion of the bolt.
