# PRODUCT CARE

All our products are produced with great care but the key to a perfect experience is not only how it is made but how it is used. Follow this guide to get the best scent from your product.

## CANDLE CARE

Always store candles in a cool dry place out of direct sunlight. This will avoid any damage to the wax, which could affect your candles performance. Before lighting ensure the wick is trimmed to approximately 5mm and remove any 'clubbing' on the wick. This will prevent the candle from smoking and ensure better scent diffusion. Please make sure the wick is centralised at all times, extinguish the flame if the wick becomes off-centre.

#### CANDLE MEMORY

The size of the wax pool on the initial burn sets the memory for the life of the candle. When you light your candle for the first time do not extinguish it until an even liquid wax pool has been created right to the edge of the glass, this can take between 3-4 hours. If you extinguish your candle before a complete wax pool has been formed then "tunnelling" will occur and you will be left with an outer rim of wasted wax.

### DRAUGHT AND WAX POOLS

Candles burn best in still air. Draughts can cause a candle to smoke or burn unevenly. Make sure they are placed away from open windows, doors and other draught sources. Match heads and wick remains in the wax pool can lead to a candle flaring due to the debris lighting the wax, so remember to remove any wick debris from the candle before burning.

### EXTINGUISHING

Blowing out your candle is not recommended as the liquid wax may splatter and the wick may continue to glow and emit smoke. The most effective way to extinguish your candle is to use a candle snuffer.

## CANDLE SAFETY TIPS

- 1. Remove all packaging before burning and always read individual candle warnings.
- 2. Never leave a candle burning unattended. Keep out of reach of children and pets.
- Do not burn candles on or near anything that can catch fire and allow ample headroom for the candle flame in a well ventilated area.

- Never allow the flame to touch the side of the glass and stop burning your candle when the wax level drops to 10mm from the base.
- Do not place candle in direct contact with a glass, marble or wooden surface whilst burning. Always place on a heat resistant surface.
- 6. Ensure the candle wax pool is free from debris prior to burning.
- 7. Always leave at least 15cm between burning candles.
- 8. Do not burn your candle for more than 4 hours at a time.
- 9. Prior to burning always check that the glass is not cracked or damaged.
- 10. Leave the candle to cool down and allow the wax to solidify before moving.
- If the candle smokes, the flame becomes too high or flickers excessively, extinguish it, then trim the wick and check for draughts before lighting again.

## DIFFUSER CARE

Unscrew the collar and remove the seal. Replace the collar and insert the reeds. Allow 48 hours for the fragrance to fill the room with the scent. For a stronger scent use all of the reeds and turn daily. For more subtle scent use fewer reeds and turn less often.

# DIFFUSER COLOURS

Each crop grows slightly differently and as a result affects the colours consistency. This is a natural result of using organic ingredients.

# DIFFUSER SAFETY TIPS

- 1. Keep out of reach of children and pets and wash hands after handling.
- Do not ingest and avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Should eye contact occur, rinse with water. Call a doctor immediately if irritation persists or if oils are ingested.
- 3. Do not light reeds or place near heat or open flames.
- Avoid contact with furniture/fabrics that may be damaged by oil. Clean spills immediately to minimise staining/damage to finished surfaces.
