MOUNTING USING THE 3M DOUBLE SIDED ADHESIVE TAPE:

- 1) Clean back of the tailgate bar with non-ammonia based cleaner and let dry completely.
- 2) Peel back clear side of 3M adhesive strip, attach to the back of the tailgate bar, and press firmly to secure.



*Space adhesive strips out evenly on the back of the tailgate bar

- 3) Clean mounting area on truck with non-ammonia based cleaner and let dry completely.
- 4) Peel back red side of 3M adhesive strip.
- 5) Attach to tailgate applying 15 PSI of pressure for 30-60 seconds.
- 6) Full adhesion is reached after 72 hours.

MOUNTING USING THE CLIP BRACKETS:

Best to use when spare tire access is blocked by the tailgate bar

- 1) Confirm placement area and use caution when drilling into vehicle.
- 2) Carefully screw clips into place so that clips are positioned towards the ends of the tailgate bar (see illustration below).
- 3) Carefully push bar into clip. You may have to gently flex clip for bar to fit in. Clip should wrap firmly around the bar.



Rear view of tailgate bar with clip brackets attached


To Release:

Hold tailgate bar to ensure it does not fall. Carefully pull the bar out of the clips. You may have to gently flex clip to release bar.


MOUNTING USING THE O-BRACKETS:

Best to use for rocker panel mounting the tailgate bar

- 1) Confirm placement area and use caution when drilling into vehicle.
- 2) Place tailgate bar inside O-Bracket clip with lights facing out and close the clip (see illustration below).
- 3) Carefully screw brackets into place spreading out evenly along vehicle to ensure tailgate bar is securely mounted.

SYNC TWO TAILGATE BARS (ROCKER PANEL INSTALLATION):

PATTERN CHANGING INSTRUCTIONS:

To change color, apply the yellow wire to +VDC for less than one second

To change patterns, apply the yellow wire to +VDC for two seconds

To activate dual color, apply the yellow wire to +VDC for two seconds, release, then repeat until dual color is reached

ALTERNATING SYNC: (One tailgate bar must be on the P1 pattern and the other must be on the P2 pattern)

- 1) Set both lights to steady burn pattern
- 2) Advance only one tailgate bar forward using the pattern change (yellow) wire
- 3) Turn lights off and connect the yellow wires
- 4) Turn both tailgate bars back on
- 5) To change patterns, you must advance forward two times so that one tailgate bar is on the P1 pattern and the other is on the P2 pattern
