


IMPORTANT!

Brad Nails 18G - 1 3/16"




Screwdrivers #6 & #8



We Recommend A 18 Gauge Nail Gun (Use 18 gauge brad nailer, with appropriate air compressor or electric nailer set to 80psi, to prevent splitting)



Starting from the back of the racks. Place the ladders on flat, soft surface, so not to damage front of racks. Space the ladders accordingly. (Note: Ensure proper placement of ladders, and bottoms are all in same direction. Left and right ladders, are placed on the ends. Bottle tilt should be in same direction.)



From the bottom and working your way up, place the back spacer bars (4b) according to the ladder notches. Make sure to carefully interlock the spacer bars to the ladders.
