## Ingredients

600 g Beef mince, 90% lean
100 g Sardines, canned in water, drained
80 g Apple, raw
80 g Carrot, raw
80 g Zucchini, raw
20 g Hempseeds, hulled
15 g CanineCeuticals Replace-A-Bone
10 g CanineCeuticals Organic Beef Liver
10 g CanineCeuticals Organic Beef Kidney
3 g (1 tsp) Fennel powder
1.5 g Cod liver oil
0.5g (1/8 tsp) Organic Kelp Powder
