

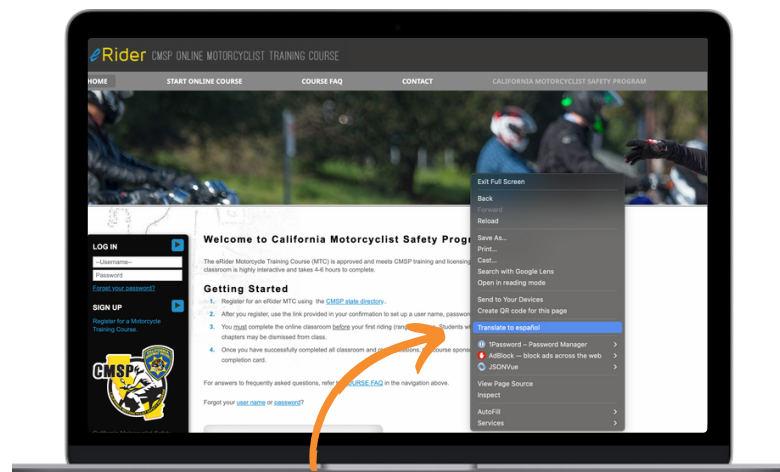
HOW TO USE ERIDER IN YOUR NATIVE LANGUAGE

You can use **Google Chrome** to translate pages and audio. You can generate live translated captions for eRider videos so you can read along in your native language while you listen to the original content.

1 - TURN ON LIVE CAPTION

1. On your computer, open Google Chrome.
- You might need to download it first.
2. At the top right, select More ⋮ > Settings.
3. Click on “Accessibility” on the left.
4. Activate “Live Caption”.
5. If you want to get Live Captions in another language other than English, you’ll need to click “Add language” next to “Supported Live Caption languages”.
6. From the pop-up list, select the language(s) you want to add, then click “Add”.

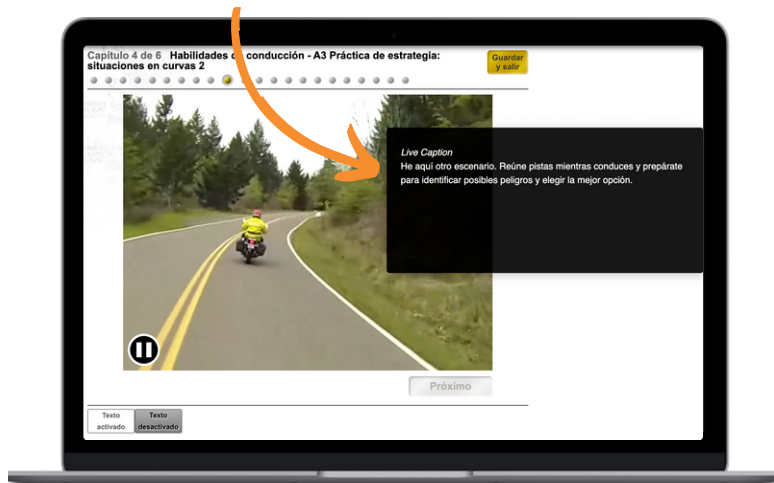


Later on, you can translate directly from the page by right-clicking, then selecting “Translate to (your preferred language)”

2 - ACTIVATE LIVE TRANSLATE

1. Similar to before, open Google Chrome.
2. At the top right, select More ⋮ > Settings.
3. On the left-hand side, click on  Languages.
4. Under “Preferred Languages” make sure to add the language you want to translate to. If it is not in the list yet, hit “Add languages” to add it. Drag and drop to sort the different languages according to your preference.
5. Under “Google Translate”, activate the button to “Use Google Translate”.
6. In the dropdown next to “Translate into this language”, it will allow you to select which language to translate to from the preferred languages you set above.
