









What you will need:


• about 12m of 3mm Braided Cord (about 48m for the set of 4)

- 6mm crochet hook
- Sharp scissors

What will you be using:

- Magic ring
- Single crochet
- Slip stitch














Start working on your crochet coaster by making a magic ring. You can find the tutorial for the magic ring here.














Make the first single crochet. You can find the tutorial <u>here.</u>














Make 8 single crochet stitches, then grab the shortest cord and pull the magic ring as tight as possible.








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By punching the crochet hook in the marked place, make a slip stitch. You can find the tutorial <u>here</u>. Tip: It would be a good idea to put a marker here to know where is the beginning and end of the row .








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Step 5

Insert the crochet hook in the marked place (under two loops) and make two single crochet stitches. Repeat for each loop.








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




On the next round, we will make 2 single crochet stitches and 1 single crochet until we have worked the whole circle (2, 1).









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Work the last round by making 1 single crochet in each loop.







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




When you finish the whole round, move on to making the petals of the flower coaster.

Make 3 single crochet stitches in the first loop, then make a slip stitch in the second loop, work all round this way.








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Make the last slip stitch. Our coaster is almost ready! Pull out the cord and turn it over.







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




Hide the cord between loops and cut off any excess.
