

ROUND COASTER



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THIS COASTER IS BASED ON A CIRCLE. YOU WILL BE USING SINGLE AND DOUBLE CROCHETS INTERCHANGEABLY TO PRACTICE BOTH STITCHES.

YOU ARE GOING TO NEED:

- 1 x BOBBINY PREMIUM 5MM 100M IN A COLOR OF YOUR CHOOSING, WE ARE USING LAUREL
- CROCHET HOOK 8-10 MM
- A ROW MARKER
- SCISSORS



DIFFICULTY LEVEL: Five circular icons, each containing the Bobbiny logo (a cursive 'B' inside a circle), arranged horizontally to indicate the difficulty level.



How to make it:

ROW 1. A ROUND OF SINGLE CROCHETS

Begin with making a magic ring and 10 single crochets:

In the place of the first single make 1 chain loop to reach the height of the stitch used here. We count this chain loop as the first single crochet. It would be a good idea to put a marker here to know where the beginning and end of the row is.

Next, make 9 more single crochets to get the total of 10.

Pull the magic ring as tightly as possible.

Close the first row with a slip stitch inserting your hook under the marked stitch.

This way you've finished the first row—make sure, that you now have 10 stitches.

HINT: BEGIN THE SINGLE CROCHET ROW LIKE THIS



How to make it:

ROW 2. A ROUND OF DOUBLE CROCHETS

Begin with making two chain loops (they will be the first stitch). This way you will reach the height of the stitch used in this row. Put a marker in the last stitch.



HINT: BEGIN THE ROW OF DOUBLE CROCHETS THIS WAY



How to make it:

ROW 2. CONTINUATION

Insert your hook under the second stitch and make 2 double crochets in it. In the following stitches make 2 double crochets. In the last stitch (the one with 2 chain loops) make 1 double crochet. This way in this stitch you will have two new stitches made, just like in all the others.

Close this row with a slip stitch inserting the hook under the marked stitch.

You should have 20 stitches after having finished this row—make sure to count them.



HINT: THIS PHOTO SHOWS WHERE TO INSERT YOUR HOOK AFTER HAVING MADE THE CHAIN LOOPS



How to make it:

ROW 3. A ROUND OF SINGLE CROCHETS

Begin with 1 chain loop and mark this stitch. Insert the hook into the second stitch and make 2 single crochets there. Then make 1 single crochet in the following stitch.

REPEAT THIS SEQUENCE [2 SINGLE CROCHETS ,1 SINGLE CROCHET] 8 MORE TIMES

Close the row with a slip stitch inserting the hook under the marked stitch. At this point you should have 30 stitches.

ROW 4. A ROUND OF DOUBLE CROCHETS

Begin with making 2 chain loops and mark the stitch.

Then make 1 double in the second and third stitch. Next, make 2 double crochets in the fourth stitch.

REPEAT THIS SEQUENCE [1,1,2] 8 MORE TIMES

And once again, in the last stitch (the one with 2 chain loops) make 1 double crochet. This way you have 2 double crochets there. Close the row with a slip stitch inserting the hook under the marked stitch. At this point you should have 40 stitches.



How to make it:

ROW 5. A ROUND OF SINGLE CROCHETS

Begin with 1 chain loop and mark this stitch. Insert the hook into the second stitch and make 2 single crochets there. Then make 2 single crochets in the next stitch and 1 single crochet in the 3 following stitches.

REPEAT THIS SEQUENCE [2,1,1,1] 8 MORE TIMES

We're sure by now you already know what to do next :)

After having finished this sequence, make 2 single crochets in the next stitch. Then, 1 single crochet in the two last stitches.

Close the row with a slip stitch inserting the hook under the marked stitch. Now, after having finished the 5th row, you should have 50 stitches.



How to make it:

ROW 6. A ROUND OF DOUBLE CROCHETS—THE LAST ONE!

Begin with making 2 chain loops and mark the stitch. Then make one double in each of the four following stitches. Next, make 2 double stitches in the 6th stitch.

REPEAT THIS SEQUENCE [1,1,1,1,2] 8 MORE TIMES.

After having finished this sequence, make 1 double crochet in each of the stitches that are left. Make 1 double crochet in the stitch with the 2 chain loops.

Close the row with a slip stitch inserting the hook under the marked stitch. Now, after having finished the 6th row, you should have 60 stitches—check if they're there!

Cut the cord, finish the project and hide the ending threading it through the stitches on the bottom of the coaster.



Your coaster is now ready!

It's a beautiful accessory that will make your morning coffee or afternoon tea time even a bit better than usual :)
