

MACRAME HEART-SHAPED KEYCHAIN







KNOTS YOU NEED TO KNOW (CLICK THE LINKS BELOW FOR TUTORIALS)

- LARK'S HEAD KNOT
- Double half hitch knot

WHAT IS NECESSARY:

- ABOUT 5M OF 3MM OR 5MM CORD
 WE RECOMMEND 3MM METALLIC CORD IN COPPER
- SHARP SCISSORS
- PIN
- CORKBOARD
- KEY RING PENDANT

How to cut the cords

- 6 x 80cm
- 2 x 10 cm










Step 1

Start working on your macrame keychain by folding the first cord in half. Then pin it to the cork board.

Step 2
Using the second cord, tie the first lark's head knot on the left side.
You can find a <u>tutorial here</u>.



Step 3

Using cord number 1 tie the first double half hitch knot on the cord no. 2. Each double half hitch knot is made with 2 loops.

Step 4Add the third cord by attaching it on the top cord using lark's head knot.







Step 5
Using cord 1 as a core tie the double half hitch knots with all three cords below.







Step 6

At this stage, your macrame heart should look like the picture above. It's already starting to look like half a heart, right? ;)









Step 7

Again, using the cord at the top as a core, make double half hitch knots with the bottom cords.





Step 8

Start knotting the next row. The cord at the top will serve as your core. Use the cords below to knot the double half hitch knot.









Step 9

This is the last row of double half hitch knots. Repeat the action from the previous step. Your heart is almost ready:)







Step 10

Turn the heart, gather the hanging strings so that they are not visible from the front of the design. Then tie a knot with a 10cm long cord.







Step 11First half of a heart is now ready! Cut off the excess cords.







Step 12

Start knotting the second half of the heart.

Pin a half-folded cord. On the part on the right, add the second cord with a Lark's head knot.




Step 13

Tie the first double half hitch knot. In the second picture you will see what the finished knot looks like.







Step 14
Using Lark's head knot, add the last cord to string number 1.









Step 15

Using cord number 1 as a core, continue tying the double half hitch knots.







Step 16
Using the same technique, tie a third row of doble half hitch knots:)









Step 17Continue tying the 4th row of double half knots. We almost finish!







Step 18

It's the last row!

Tie it using the same technique as the previous ones.











Step 19Turn the heart over and tie a knot with 10cm long cord.

Step 20Cut off the excess cords. :)









Step 20

Congratulations! Your heart is ready!
