Vest

Instructions for use

This Impact vest is for Watersport.

This Impact vest is not a buoyancy aid or life jacket and will not save you from drowing. This Impact vest despite name, will not offer full protection against impact or bodily injury and will not prevent spinal injuries.

This Impact vest will not provide the user with any significant thermal protection.

Prior to every use make a comprehensive inspection of the article paying close attention to closures and Seans.

If you find any failures or damage to materials, seams, closures or find permanent movement/relocation of internal foam padding please contact your local dealer for repair or replacement.

Fitting

When fitting this product make sure that all closures and buckles are fastened tightly giving a close fit to the torso. If the vest is loose, rises up after tightening any available straps then the vest is too large and a smaller size must be fitted. Be sure movement of torso or arms is sufficiently free to permit safe aquatic sports participation including the ability to swim.

Breathing must not be restricted in any way.

When evaluating fit, bear in mind neoprene can increase in every dimension by up to 5% when wet.

For extra protection the user should consider the use of other protective gear including bit not limited to helmets, braces, and pads. If this Impact vest is used in rough water conditions or has alterations made to it then it will dramatically reduce the performance and endanger the user. This product includes synthetic man made materials and fibers which may cause allergic reactions in certain persons. Please be sure that these materials will not cause an allergic reaction to you before using the vest in pursuing aquatic sports activities.

Care intructions

Rinse your Impact vest with fresh water and hang to drip dry (no wire hangers) after every use out of direct sungliht. Occasionally hand-wash your Impact vest using a mild detergent and cold water.

Do not use a washing machine, tumble dryer or dry clean.

Do not bleach.

Do not Iron.

Failure to clean will eventually damage the vest and reduce flexibility possibly resulting in material failure. The vest should be replaced after approximately 10 years use from the date of purchase. Store your Impact vest in a cool, dry place.

Warranties

Under the above guideline, will repair or replace at our sole discretion, your product if found, under normal use and proper care, to be defective. The decision to replace or repair a product is made by warranty department after receipt of the defective product.

The following are not covered by the warranty

- Wear due to normal use
- Accidental injuries such as tears and holes

- Fades when exposed to sunlight
- Damage caused by strong cleaning agents, chemicals or rinse aids
- Repairs or modifications not performed by an authorized dealer
- Warranty claim without original document
- For use in commercial, rental, educational or training programs or activities
- Using the wrong size
- Rinse your diving suit in fresh water after each use
- After rinsing, fold your waist in half and leave it dry, out of direct sunlight
- Do not store your diving suit in direct sunlight
