## NON-SLIP Bowl Cozy Template Set

IMPORTANT NOTE: It is imperative to use $100 \%$ cotton batting, $100 \%$ cotton fabric and $100 \%$ cotton thread in the construction of these bowls. We recommend The Gypsy Quilter ${ }^{\circledR}$ Cotton Battings on a roll \#TGQHECB12 and \#TGQHECB18. Or, if you prefer, The Gypsy Quilter ${ }^{\ominus}$ Pre-cut Bowl Cozy \#TGQ036 and Large Bowl Cozy \#TGQ103 Battings may be used.

Small Bowl:
2 - 11" squares of 100\% Cotton Fabric (Do not use anything with metallic accents)
$2-11$ " squares of $100 \%$ Cotton Batting
Large Bowl:
2 - 16" squares of 100\% Cotton Fabric (Do not use anything with metallic accents)
2 - 16" squares of $100 \%$ Cotton Batting

## Cutting:

1. Fold the fabric squares into quarters.
2. Place template edges marked "Folded Edge" along the folded edges of the fabric
3. Rotary cut around the curved edge of the template and the darts. Do not cut the folded edges.

4. Remove the template and unfold the fabric or batting.
5. Repeat for the batting squares.

## To construct one bowl:

1. Pair a prepped piece of cotton fabric right side up on a prepped piece of cotton batting. Align the edges. Quilts as desired. Make a simple X from outer corner to outer corner, or use your favorite template or method to create a unique design. Make a total of two quilted units.
2. Align the dart edges, and sew $1 / 4$ " seam. Press seams open. Repeat for 2nd set to create lining.
3. Place the 2 matching sized bowls right side together. Matching seams and raw edges. Pin.
4. Stitch around the outside edge of the bowl with $1 / 4$ " seam. Leave a 3 " opening for turning.
5. Clip seam allowances. Turn right side out and stitch opening closed. Press the outside edges to help smooth out the bowl, and top-stitch to finish.
