


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
## How to Quilt Stacked Flowers

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
Align the middle horizontal reference line along the edge of an area.




Quilt along the next three curves.




Reposition the ruler to the original starting point as shown.
Use the reference line to ensure the ruler is straight.




Repeat the steps above until you reach the edge of the area.













Reposition the ruler as shown below, ensuring the middle reference line is even with the top of the first row. Quilt along the ruler, stopping when you touch the previously quilted row.



Repeat the steps above to quilt the second row.



Continue quilting rows until the area is completely quilted.






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
## How to Quilt Flower Borders

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Position the ruler, aligning the bottom reference line along the edge of the border.




Quilt along the outside of the ruler until you reach the bottom of the border.




Slide the ruler down so that the horizontal reference line that is second from the top is aligned with the


seam.




Quilt along the ruler until reaching the edge of the border.





Slide the ruler down so that the top reference line is aligned on the bottom seam of the border.



Quilt along the top of the ruler.









Reposition the ruler so that the bottom horizontal reference line is aligned to the bottom seam of the border.

Quilt along the outer edge of the ruler, then repeat the steps above until you reach the end of the area.








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
# How to Quilt Triangle Scallops

Use the Petunia ruler to fill in triangle shaped areas, such as blocks or setting triangles, with adorable scallops.


Position the ruler so that the top horizontal reference line is along the bottom seam of the area. Quilt along the top arc of the ruler until you reach the bottom seam.



Repostion the ruler so as shown, then repeat to guilt arcs along the bottom seam.



After quilting the last arc, keep the ruler in place and back track along the arc until you reach the center reference line.







Repostion the ruler to begin quilting the next row. Use the reference lines on the ruler to ensure the proper placement.

Vertical reference line should align at the point where the two previously quilted clamshells meet.


Horizontal reference line should be even with the top of the previously quilted clamshells.





Quilt arcs along the second row, repositioning the ruler in between each one as in the first row. Stop when you reach the first arc.



Keep the ruler in place and back track along the arc until you reach the center reference line. Quilt another row of arcs until you reach the end of the rown








Repeat until the area is completely filled in.




## How to Quilt Circles




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Quilt along the inner curve of the Petunia ruler, from needle stop to needle stop.




Rotate the ruler 180 degrees & use reference lines to ensure that it's straight.




Quilt along the curve of the ruler.

### **Quilting A Row of Circles**




Quilt along the inner curve of the Petunia ruler, from needle stop to needle stop.



Slide the ruler over so that the foot of the machine is on

the first needle stop. Use the reference lines to ensure that the ruler is straight. The quilt along the curve of the ruler

Repeat steps above quilting the desired number of arcs.




After quilting the final arc, rotate the ruler 180 degrees and use the reference lines to ensure that it is straight. Quilt along the curve of the ruler until reaching the next needle stop. Slide the ruler over and repeat until reaching the beginning of the row.







## Overlapped Arcs

Quilt one row of arcs from one side of the area to the other.



Shift the ruler over so that the middle reference line is along the edge of the area. Quilt along the seam until you touch the ruler.





Quilt along the ruler until reaching the bottom of the area. Reposition ruler and repeat until reaching the edge.
