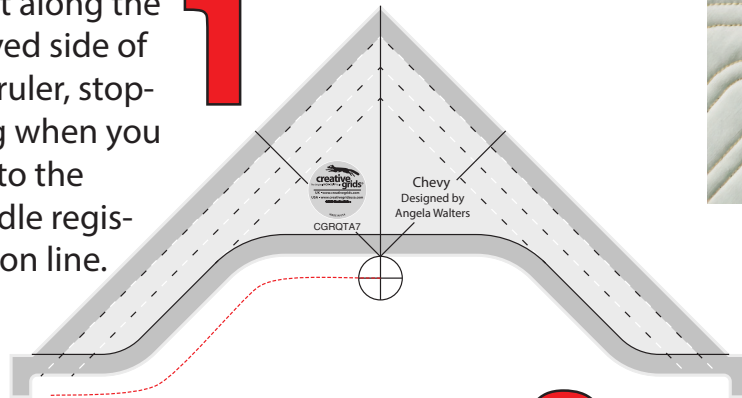


Allover Designs



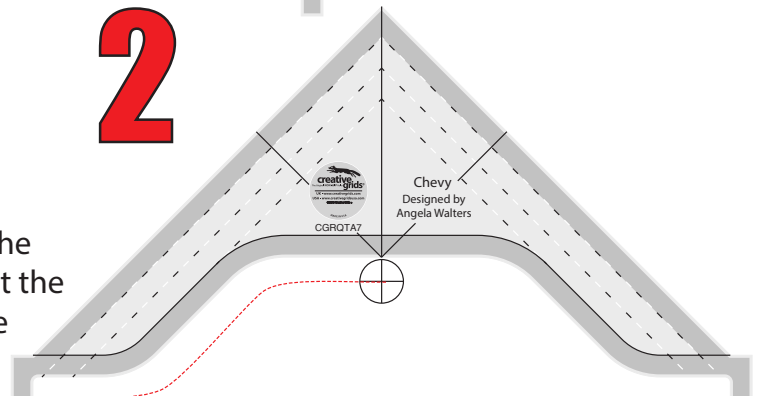
Quilt along the curved side of the ruler, stopping when you get to the middle registration line.

Reposition the ruler so that the foot of the machine is against the needle stop. Then quilt to the middle line again.

Once you reach the end of the area, travel along the edge of the block until you are 1/4" - 1/2" away from the previously quilted line. Reposition the ruler, then quilt until you reach the needle stop. Repeat the steps above until the whole area is filled in.

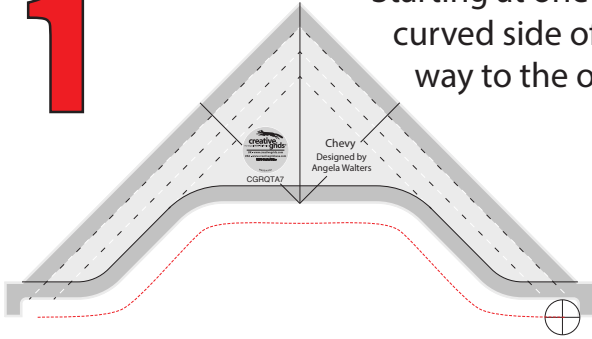

Quilting With Chevy

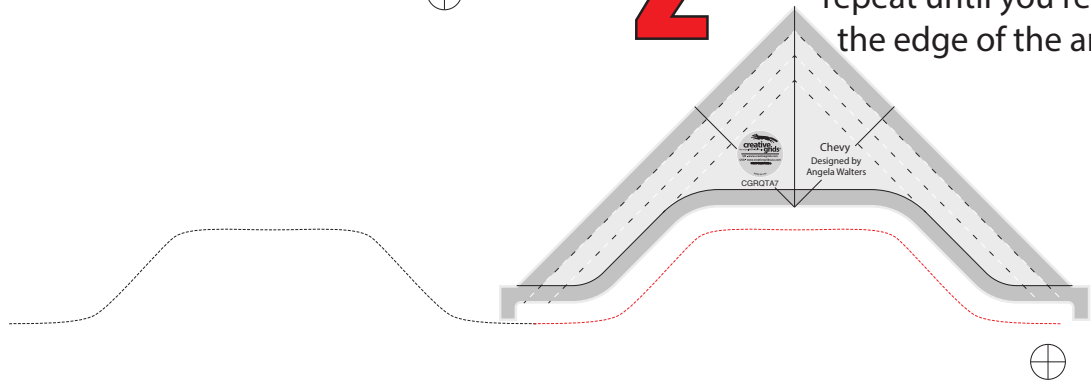

Starting at one end, quilt along the curved side of the ruler all the way to the other end.

Reposition the ruler and repeat until you reach the edge of the area.



3

Travel along the edge of the area about 1/4". Rotate ruler and repeat the steps above, quilting a line that's a mirror image of the first one.

Fill in the whole area, alternating the ruler orientation. For a different look, you can echo each row before moving onto the next one.
