


Woven

Natura Sectional
Assembly Instructions

STEP 1

Unbox your new sectional pieces and layout all the parts.

Box Contents

Corner:

- 1x Base
- 1x Left Back
- 1x Right Back
- 1x Base Cushion
- 2x Back Cushions
- 2x Clips

Box Contents

Slipper:

- 1x Base
- 1x Back
- 1x Base Cushion
- 1x Back Cushion
- 2x Clips

Box Contents


Ottoman:

- 1x Base
- 1x Base Cushion
- 2x Clips



STEP 2

Place the base on the ground. The base is universal, so the position of the base is not important.




STEP 3

For corner units, find the left and right back rests and insert them into the slot in the base, giving them a slight push with your body weight to get them fully inserted.


Pay attention to the slots on the sides of the back rests. The larger slots should be positioned to the outside and the smaller slots should be positioned in the corner where the two back rests meet.

For slipper units, follow the directions for the corner units but you will only have 1 back rest.

For ottomans, simply position the ottoman where desired. The ottoman can be affixed with clips or free standing.



Corner Unit




Slipper Unit

STEP 4

Assemble the additional corners units and slipper units into the configuration you desire. This applies to Loveseat, Sofa, and Sectional configurations.




Sectional Configuration

STEP 5

Use metal clips provided and slip them over the base frames to connect multiple units.

Use 2x per section.







STEP 6

Once your configuration is assembled, place the bottom cushions on the sectional, paying attention to the corners of the cushions.

For the corner sectionals the bottom cushion will have 3 square corners and 1 rounded corner. The rounded corner will go on the exposed corner on the front.


For the slipper sectional the bottom cushion will have 2 square corners and 2 rounded. The 2 rounded corners on the front of the chair and the 2 square corners will go against the back edge of the chair.

For ottomans, all 4 corners are rounded and are universal. Place the zipper against the adjacent sectional to hide the zipper.



STEP 7

Place the back cushions.
