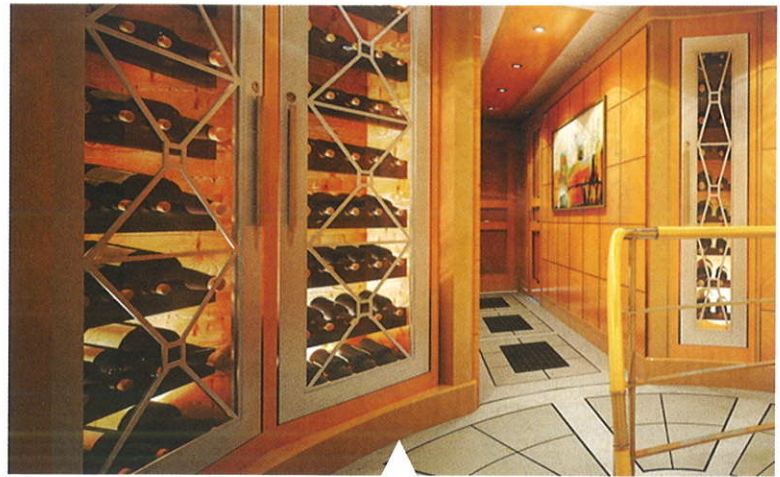




# Six of the best

• **A2**
