### **Game of Stones**

Mancala is an ancient game, with many variations played all around the world. Some historians believe Mancala was played over 5,000 years ago in ancient Sumeria and many believe it was played over 3,000 years ago in Sudan. Holes in the ground discovered in Egyptian temples lead many to believe Mancala was played in ancient Egypt before 1400 BC, travelling to other parts of Africa and the Middle East. Another theory suggests the game originated in Africa and travelled to Egypt 2,000 years ago, with ancient boards found in Zimbabwe, Uganda and Ghana.

## **How To Play**

Many variations can be played, including the popular basic version of Mancala, also known as Kalah.

The aim is to capture more stones than your opponent. Players "sow" and "capture" seeds or stones and place them in their 'Mancala' or store at the end of the board.

- Four stones are placed in each of the 12 holes on the Mancala board. The colour of the stones is irrelevant.
- The board is placed between you and your opponent the long side facing you.
- Each player has 6 holes and a 'Mancala' (a larger hole or store) to their right, at the end of the
- To begin, one player collects all 4 stones from any one of the 6 holes on their side.
- Anticlockwise, the player places the stones one by one in each hole in succession, starting with the hole next to the hole they collected from.
- If you get to your own store along the way, you may place one stone in it, but you must skip your opponent's store.
- If the last stone you place is your own store, you take a free turn.
- If the last stone you drop is in an empty hole on your side, capture that stone and any stones in the hole directly above.
- The game is over when all 6 holes on one side of the Mancala board are empty.
- The player with stones left in their side of the board captures those stones.

#### The Winner

Count all the stones in each player's store. The player with the most stones wins.

#### Little Tip;

On your first turn, play the hole 5 holes away from your Mancala. The last stone you place will be in your Mancala so you get a free turn!

Think ahead and use strategy to collect as many stones as you can.


