Trampoline Ladder Instruction Manual

Trampoline Ladder

Before You Start

Read the Instruction Manual and Warnings in full

Please make sure you read the instruction manual and all warnings in full before you begin installing your trampoline ladder. Keep these instructions for future reference as they contain very important inspection and maintenance advice which will help you keep your trampoline ladder in a good and safe condition.



Warnings

Please read and understand the following warnings before installing and using your trampoline ladder

Warning! Maximum user weight is 100kg.

Warning! The trampoline ladder is intended for outdoor family/domestic use only.

Warning! The trampoline ladder should be assembled by an adult in accordance with the assembly instructions and thereafter checked before the first use to ensure it is correctly attached and the screws are tight.

Warning! This ladder is not suitable for children under 3 years.

Warning! Young children should not use unless supervised by an adult.

Warning! Improper use of this ladder can cause injury.

Warning! Remove ladder when trampoline is not in use to prevent young children from climbing onto the trampoline.

Warning! Do not exit the trampoline with a jump - do not jump on or off this ladder while exiting the trampoline or climbing onto the trampoline.

Inspection & Maintenance

 ${\it It is important you make regular safety checks on your trampoline ladder ideally before each use.}$



Steps and Side Rails

Make sure the steps are securely in place and are not excessively worn. Make sure the steps are clean and dry before use. Check the side rails for rust and wear and tear. Make sure the screws are tight and the steps are in the correct positions.

Attachment to the Trampoline

Make sure the hooks on the ladder are firmly hooked onto the trampoline.

Place pressure on the steps to ensure it is sitting firmly on the ground and the steps are securely in place before use.

Assembling the Top Step



You will need: Left and Right Side Rails (part 1) Step (part 3) Bolts and Nuts x 2 (part 4)

Take a seat! No really - you might find this part easiest sitting down on a chair or on the floor!

Take one of the side rails and turn it so the hook is at the top and facing away from you. Slide the first step onto the side rail. The wider/fatter part of the step should be on the same side as the hook (if the hook is facing away from you, the slope of the step should be coming towards you).

Making sure the holes in the side rail and step are lined up., turn the step and rail upside down - you need to drop the nut into the rectangular hole next to the pole - see Fig 1.

To ensure the nut is the correct way round, make sure the flat/threaded side is facing outwards towards the pole. The side containing the plastic stopper should face away from the pole.

You will need to put the bolt through the hole in the step then the side rail to secure the step in place. It may take a little bit of movement to get the bolt in position.

Use the screwdriver to tighten the bolt (this will screw into the nut that you placed into the hole) until it is secured - see Fig 2. Make sure the bolt has been screwed all the way in!

Repeat this process for the other side.

Assembling the Bottom Step

You will need:
Left and Right Side Rails & Top Step (as assembled in step 1)
Step (part 3)
U Shaped Bottom Rail (part 2)
Bolts and Nuts x 2 (part 4)


With the top step in place slide the bottom step onto the side rails so the two are touching. Make sure it is the same way round as the top step (with the slant towards you and the hooks away from you).

Insert the side rails into the U Shaped Bottom Rail of the ladder (part 2). The best way to do this is to line them up on both sides before you push them in.

Pull the second step down into place (in line with the holes on the side rails) and repeat step 2 to secure it in place.

Check the ladder to make sure all the screws are nice and tight and in position.

The ladder is ready to use! Lift the pads on your trampoline and use the hook at the top to securely attach the ladder to the frame of your trampoline.
