



This game must be assembled by an adult or under adult supervision. It can be played indoors or outdoors but should be stored indoors in a cool dry place when not in use. Because this game is made of plastic, it can be wiped clean with warm soapy water. Make sure you dry the game out before storing.


## Set Up




Take the two bottom leg sections (D) and insert the counter (F) into hole 'Y'

Slot the bottom frame section (B) into the bottom leg sections (D) by inserting the tabs into the holes and pushing down.






Slot the top frame section (A) into the top leg sections (C) using the same method as you did in Step 2.




Slot the top leg sections (C) into the bottom leg sections (D) - by inserting the round pegs 'W' into the holes 'X'.



Note: You can secure the top and bottom frame together using the blue frame section clips (part G).

Slide the two blue sliders (E) into the base of the frame - the slot is labelled 'Z' in this diagram.

They should slide all the way in to meet in the middle. These sliders will stop the counters from falling out of the bottom of the frame during your game.

## **Playing the Game**

Take it in turns to drop one of your coloured counters into one of the columns through the slots at the top - but be careful, you could set your opponent up to win if you are not thinking ahead!



## **Game Tactics**

Think about blocking your opponent from making a line while building up counters in a winning line at the same time. The killer tactic is is to build up more than one winning line, this will force your opponent to block one line leaving the other free - allowing you to complete a line and win.

The first player to get four of their counters in an uninterrupted row either diagonally, horizontally or vertically is the winner! When you are ready to play again simply pull the two sliders out to release the counters.




