

As 20th Century Fox Makeup Director, Ben Nye, Sr. designed an ensemble of time-honored characters now immortalized on the silver screen. We encourage you to create your own characters with Ben Nye Makeup as you follow our professional directions.

GETTING STARTED The Kit includes all the basic components required to create this design. Colors are concentrated, so be careful to use them sparingly. The optional items listed below will enable you to achieve more professional results.

If time permits, practice your makeup design. Plan to spend at least forty-five minutes to complete your character. We recommend applying *Ben Nye's Quick Cleanse* for fast clean-up followed with cleanser and water.

PREPARATION Clean face with *Hydra Cleanse*, or soap and water before applying makeup. Use an astringent to remove any oiliness. Discontinue use if skin irritation occurs. Parental supervision is required for use on children.

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Apply Witch Foundation to face, neck, ears and lips with sponge. Pat sponge over entire face to even texture.
- 2. Apply Forest Green with a flat brush as shown. Deepen shadows with Steel Grey. Apply to chin for cleft.
- 3. Soften hard contour lines with sponge or brush. Stipple (or pat) Witch Foundation lightly over shadows (like a "wash") for subtlety.
- 4. Apply Yellow highlights with a flat brush just above shadow contours as follows: above cheek bones, forehead, bridge of nose, lips, chin, front and sides of neck.
- 5. Wrinkle Details: Apply very fine lines with a sharpened *Black Pencil* under eyes, on upper eye socket, outer eyes ("crowsfeet") across cheeks, chin, forehead area, and neck.
- 6. Fine Highlights: With a small flat brush, alternate Yellow and Ultralite shades beneath wrinkle details in Step 5.
- 7. Lip Wrinkles: Tightly pucker lips to exaggerate wrinkles. Apply Yellow on high points of lips to create highlights. Shadow creases ("wrinkles") with sharp Black Pencil. Powder entire makeup with Neutral Set Face Powder. Distress teeth with Black Pencil.
- 8. Etch Eyebrows: Brush eyebrows upwards with brow/lash comb, toothbrush, or clean mascara wand. With a sharp *Black Pencil*, etch fine brow lines upward through eyebrows. Brush with *Clear Mascara* to set eyebrows upwards.
- 9. Warts, Age Spots, Teeth: Draw a small circle of color with *Black Creme* or *Pencil*. Apply *Yellow* to center for warts. Apply light spots of *Steel Grey* for age spots. Add additional shadows and highlights as needed. Powder. If desired, distress teeth with *Tooth Colors*. Apply false eyelashes, mascara, style hair or add wig, hat and costume.
