

GETTING STARTED This Kit includes all the basic components required to create this design. Colors are concentrated, so be careful to use them sparingly. The optional items listed below will enable you to achieve more professional results.

> Neutral Set Face Powder Brush Cleaner Extra Flat Brushes

Extra Sponge Sections Velour Powder Puff Pencil Sharpener

Practice makes perfect so plan to practice your makeup design. Anticipate spending about forty-five minutes to complete your character. For easy removal, apply Quick Cleanse, followed by Hydra Cleanse or soap and water.

PREPARATION Clean face with Hydra Cleanse or soap and water before applying makeup. Discontinue use if skin irritation occurs. Parental supervision is required for use on children.

## DIRECTIONS

- 1. With Black Pencil, outline contours as shown in photo to include: cheek hollows, eye sockets, jagged nose, temples and neck vertebrae.
- 2. White: Apply White Foundation with latex sponge. Apply to smaller areas with a flat brush.
- 3. Black: Apply Black creme makeup with brush or small sponge as shown, including ears. Darken outlines at temples and across mouth.
- 4. Blend: With a brush or sponge, blend forehead and temple areas as shown to create a subtle grey shadow. Soften cheek shadows into a sweeping arc toward nose. Soften edges of eye sockets with brush or swab.

Powder: With a large puff, apply Neutral Set Face Powder. Remove excess powder with powder brush or puff. Dab a moistened sponge over makeup to intensify color.

5. Details: Gently apply Yellow shadow to distress facial contours. With a sharp Black Pencil, draw fine vertical lines on lips and around

Rotted Teeth: Dry teeth with tissue. Color teeth unevenly as shown with Black Pencil, or use Ben Nye Tooth Colors.

- 6. Red: With a small flat brush, apply Red vertically from forehead down to chin.
- 7. Skeletal Teeth: Draw teeth outlines on upper and lower lips with a sharpened Black Pencil. Randomly shade teeth with White, Black and Yellow cremes.

Touch up with additional colors as desired. Powder again if needed to set makeup completely. Complete character with a black shroud, hooded cape or similar costume.
