



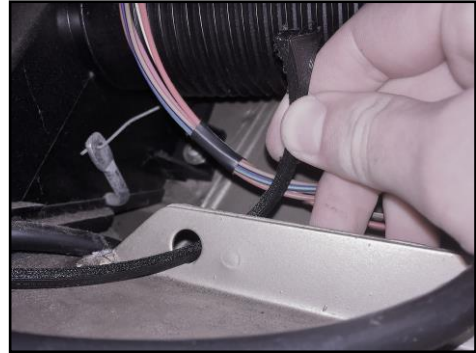

## GLOVE-STRAP

Glove Box Catches for  
1980-1991 Vanagon

These straps will allow you to regain the hold-open function of your glove box if the original straps have failed (early models) or if the plastic hooks on the glove box have broken off (late models). These are an easy-to-install direct replacement.

- 1) Open the glove box. Behind it—on the left side—you will find a hole in the sheet metal. Thread the strap with the cone-shaped end through that hole.



- 2) Insert the ball end of the other strap firmly into the slot on the right side.



- 3) Hook the free ends of both straps into the appropriate spots on the back of the glove box. The right side uses the hook as shown in Figure C. The left side of the glove box may have two possible strap mounting points (Figures D and E). Choose the one that allows for proper strap extension when the both straps are installed and the glove box is open.
