Interior LED Bulb Kit – Vanagon Westfalia Full Camper

Map Light

1. Remove the light housing from the dash (pry out with a small flat blade screwdriver). Be careful when removing the housing, as the positive connection on this fixture is NOT insulated (do NOT touch it to the vehicle metal!). You do not need to disconnect the wiring; only pull the housing out far enough to safely access the bulb.
2. Remove the stock bulb and replace it with the new LED. Snap the housing back into place.

Dome Light

1. Remove the housing in the same manner as the map light. Be careful when removing the housing, as the positive connection on this fixture is NOT insulated (do NOT touch it to the vehicle metal!). You do not need to disconnect the wiring; only pull the housing out far enough to safely access the bulb.
