KEFALONIA

...a small winery in Thiramonas, a picturesque village in southern Kefalonia. There, Nikos Petraopoulos and his team continue a centuries-old family tradition.

The Ainos mountain, combined with the seismic nature and different soil compositions, gives Kefalonia a variety of terroirs with many different microclimates, even at very short distances.

Under the supervision of oenologist Kiki Siameli, the winery focuses on terroir driven wines, organic viticulture, low intervention and small vat fermentations.

Petraopoulos makes just about 25.000 bottles per year, from local varieties like Robola, Mavrodaphne (own rooted, pre-phyloxera, 60yr old vines) and Zakynthino.

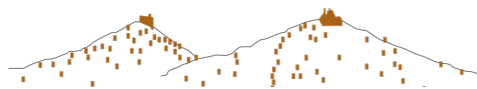

OUSYRA



The Ousyra Winery is a family run winery on the Greek island of Syros, creating terroir-driven wines from rare indigenous Cycladic varieties.

Ousyra was founded by Edward Maitland-Makgill-Crichton and his wife Eileen. A story of love, where a Scottish sommelier, proceeded to move to Greece to turn this love into action and become a winemaker.

The vineyards are ungrafted and organically farmed, something is really rare to see, especially for Serifiotiko and Fokiano varieties.

Expect to taste an underline salinity in these wines, due to the proximity to the sea, which makes them pair exceptionally well with food.

Tsiakkas winery was established in 1988 just outside Pelendri village on the Troodos Mountains, in the Pitsilia wine region.

In recent years, the winery has seen a shift towards native varieties such as the rare Yiannoudin and Promara, while also innovating on the well-established varieties like Xynisteri and Vamvakada.

The region boasts some of the highest altitude vineyards in all of Europe.

The vineyards are located in the Troodos ophiolite, a layered geological structure raised through the ocean floor as a result of complex plate tectonic movements. This means that the vines are growing on geology that is normally found kilometres deep under the Earth's surface.

KITRVS is a small winery in Pydna (Kitros), run by our childhood friends, family Garypidis. Their winery is between the Aegean sea and Mount Olympus.

The Garypidis family belongs to some of the most serious winemakers in the country. Their attention to detail is unique and meticulous in all stages of winemaking.

Just as unique, is the winery building. The placement and rotation of each brick was determined through an augmented reality system, giving the walls a fluid look.

Controlled irrigation of the vineyards and green harvesting ensures low yield and achievement of the maximum concentration of the fruit.

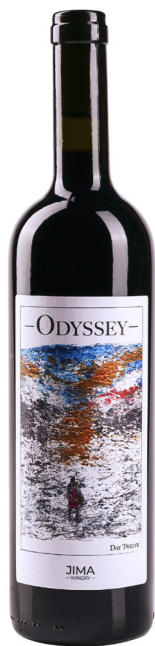

OENOGENESIS

Oenogenesis is the creation of Bakis Tsalkos, an oenologist with extensive experience in Montpellier and Bordeaux, responsible for the renaissance of Drama as a wine region.

The Mediterranean climate of this region is characterized by wet, mild winters and warm summers, thanks to the mountain Paggaio and the sea breeze of the Aegean Sea.

All Oenogenesis wines are made with long-term aging in mind and age at least 5 months on the lees.

The winery is a pleasing surprise to all visitors due to its stunning Macedonian architectural style. A fortress-like structure, make it reminiscent of a Mt Athos monastery or Macedonian manor houses that have been joined together.

KTIMA
BAIRAKTARIS

Bairaktaris is a modern winery at the entrance of Nemea, the largest winemaking region of Greece.

The philosophy of Ktima Bairaktaris lies in the natural cultivation of the vineyards to ensure excellent grape quality. They follow natural vinification methods, without fermentation additives, so that the wines better express their varietal characteristics.

The winery has a total vineyard area of approximately 17 hectares. Approximately 85% of its production is based on privately owned vineyards and the remaining 15% by cooperating producers - mainly for the production of Moschofilero.

Coming from Nemea, they believe in the Agiorgitiko's grape dynamic and its ability to evolve over the years.
