
Meet Our Team...

The Bee Haven BEE'S!

As ethical beekeepers Bee Haven only take beeswax and honey that the bees themselves do not need. Using 100% of this in their skin and bodycare products.

They prefer not to clip the Queen Bee's wings, and interfere with the natural balance of the colony as little as possible.

Emma and David tend to approx 14 hives (that number can change from year to year).

They keep Native Irish Black Honeybees and their main apiary is in a re-wilded landfill site in County Down, Northern Ireland. They also have colonies on an island in the middle of a private wetland, known as Bee Island.

Together they breed, and rear, their own native Queen bees (known as Queen Rearing). A complicated, but fun, addition to the usual beekeeping tasks. Queen Rearing native species not only helps to replenish and grow their own stock, but also helps the numbers of Ireland's native bee which is sadly in decline.

They are truly blessed to feel so connected to nature.
