

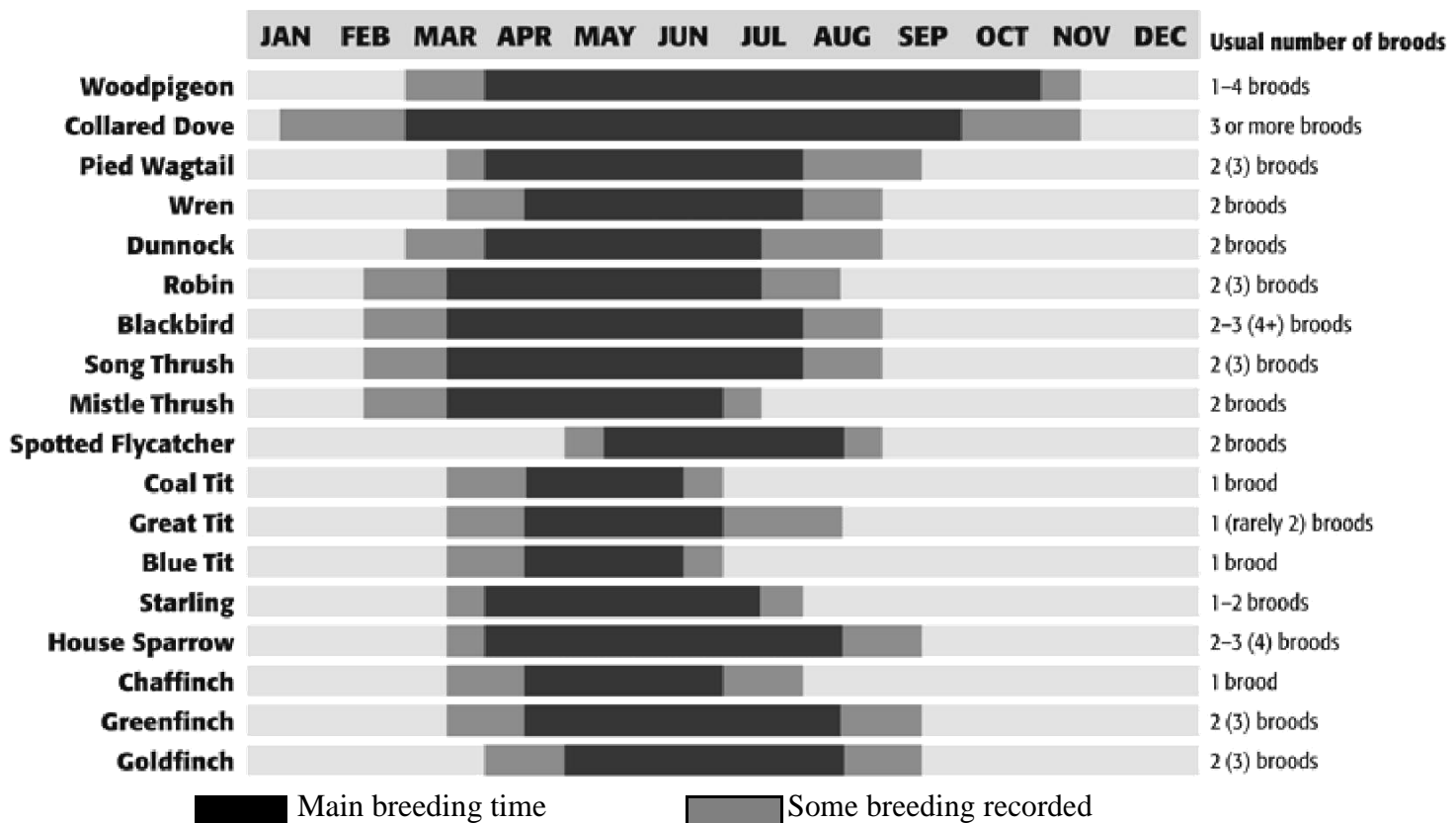
# Bird nesting times

This chart shows when different types of birds nest and how many broods they have. A 'brood' is one set of chicks. Some birds only have one brood, that is, they only raise one family. Other birds may have two or even three broods. When they have raised one family of chicks, they lay more eggs and raise another family.
