Installing or changing front fork on Dolomite Legacy, Symphony, Maxi+, Alpha, Jazz

Open walker and lock into place, Set walker on horizontal position with front wheels up



Remove black hub cap from end with axle using small screwdriver to pry off



Using 13mm socket and 13 mm boxed end wrench, loosen axle nut



Remove axle nut and pull axle through wheel, being careful not to lose black shims on either side of axle



With front wheel removed, you can access 19mm nut that attaches front fork to frame



Once 19mm nut is removed, you can remove front fork by tapping on plastic dust cover. When fork and dust cover have been removed, you can use a 19mm wrench to remove stud that attaches fork to frame

Installing new fork



Insert stud on fork unto threaded end of frame. Tighten finger tight. Using 19mm socket on nut inside from, tighten fork stud. Insert axle through one side of fork, just enough to allow you to insert front wheel into fork, keeping black axle shims between fork and wheel



Slide axle through wheel and other side of fork keeping second black axle shim between wheel and axle. Install axle nut. Using 13mm socket and 13mm box end wrench tighten axle nut.



Install hubcaps to cover head of axle and axle nut. Congratulations, Mission Accomplished
