

Primate Diet Comparison

Choosing the correct primate diet will depend on the type of primate and health status of the animal. Diabetic animals will do best on a low starch and sugar diet (Primate LS), but other primates would also benefit from this higher fiber and low starch diet. Consult individual diet spec sheets for full nutrient profiles and feeding directions.
