

Bobbiny

Striped Crochet
Pillowcase





You will need:

- About 270g of Friendly Yarn (we used Mustard and Natural colors)
- 4mm crochet hook
- Scissors
- Sewing needle
- Pillow filling 40cm x 40cm

You will be using:

- Half double crochet
- Chain loop

Dimensions of the finished pillow: 40cm x 40cm



Step 1

Let's start.

Make 61 chain loops.

Step 2

Start making one half double crochet stitch in every loop of chain.

Step 3

After working a row of half double crochet stitches, make one chain loop in the last loop.



Step 4

Turn the project, and continue making half double crochet stitches.



Step 5

Make 10 rows of half double crochet stitches.



Step 6

In the last loop of the 10th row, change the yarn for a Natural and cut the Mustard one leaving 10 cm of reserve.

Step 7

Continue making half double crochet stitches with Natural yarn.



Step 8

At this point your pillowcase should look like on the photo above.

Make 5 rows of half double crochet stitches with Natural yarn in total.



Step 9

Change the yarn to Mustard and continue making half double crochet stitches.



Step 10

Make 10 rows with Mustard yarn in total.



Step 11

Change the yarn to Natural and make 5 rows.



Step 12

Make four strips with Mustard yarn and three with Natural yarn in total.



Step 13

After you made the last loop, cut the yarn leaving a large margin that will be needed to sew the pillowcase.



Step 14

Make the other side of the pillowcase in the same way.



Step 15

Secure the ends of the yarn by tying a knot, then hide them between the stitches inside the pillowcase using a sewing needle.



Step 16

Using a needle and a previously prepared yarn, sew a pillowcase.

Tip: remember to sew the pillowcase so that the parts with hidden yarn will be inside of the pillowcase.



Step 17

Put the pillow filling inside and sew it.

Tip: you can also sew in a zipper or sew on buttons to make the pillowcase removable.



Step 18

Once you sew the pillow, cut off the excess yarn and secure it inside the pillow.
