How to Play

Hit the centre of the drum skin 1 with a flat palm and pull away your hand quickly after striking.





The djembe originates from West Africa, dating back to at least 1300 AD.



Traditionally made from a hard/dense wood with a goatskin head.



Striking the djembe skin in different positions alters the pitch of the drum.

Strike the edge of the djembe with slightly arched fingers. The 2 bottom of your fingers should be hitting the edge of the rim.



Cup your hand and strike the edge of the drum with your Ingertips. This should be a fast movement to get a bright sound.
