How to Play

Hold a beater in each hand,between your index finger and thumb.



Strike the centre of the bar with your beater and release immediately after striking.



Aim to keep the beater around

5cm above the bars, to enable
you to be precise when chiming
your notes.



Did you Know?



The word glockenspiel is a German word consisting of two parts "glocken" - bells - and "spiel" - to play.



The glockenspiel is different to the xylophone as its bars are made out of metal instead of wood.
