Connecting the TVAW4K Pro receiver (RX) to the "USB Touch" output of a touch panel allows you to use the touch functionality of the screen to control your laptop – wirelessly.

Installation of the TVAW4K Pro

- 1. Connect the HDMI OUT of the TVAW4K Pro **receiver** (RX), to one of the HDMI inputs of the touch panel, using a 4K certified HDMI cable
- 2. Connect one of the USB ports of the TVAW4K Pro **receiver** (RX), to the "USB Touch" port on the touch panel
- 3. Connect your laptop via its HDMI output to the HDMI IN of the TVAW4K Pro **transmitter** (TX), using a 4K certified HDMI cable
- 4. Connect one of the laptop's USB ports to the Micro USB input labeled "PC" of the TVAW4K Pro **transmitter** (TX), using the supplied Micro USB cable.
- 5. In case you want to use the on-screen touch keyboard on the touch panel to control your laptop, you must enable this functionality in your laptop's settings.

E.g. for Windows II go to: "*Settings > Time & Language > Typing "* and enable the function "*Show the touch keyboard when there's no keyboard attached*"
