SYMBOL KEY & DEFINITIONS



Hybrid variety: Cross between two genetically distinct parent lines chosen for specific traits, using traditional breeding methods. Hybrids typically show better vigor, uniformity of size and shape, and disease resistance than open pollinated varieties.



Organic: Seeds are grown and produced in organic systems without the use of synthetic elements.



Untreated: Seeds are grown in conventional systems, but have no further synthetic elements on the actual seed.



Treated: Seeds are grown under conventional systems and have a synthetic coating that is brightly colored (red, green, and blue are common). When handling treated seeds, it is suggested to use gloves and a mask. For organic growers, treated seeds are prohibited.

FarMore: seed treatment provides early season protection against seed and seedling diseases, as well as cucumber beetle.

Cruiser: seed treatment provides early season protection from sucking, chewing and soil pests.





BASICS

Answer these questions to help determine what type of sweet corn will best fit your need:

Do you have the ability to isolate between types of sweet corn? All corns need to be isolated from each other if you are planting different colors and different types.

- Isolation options are:
 -250 ft. between variety plantings or
- -10 days between maturity or
- -A completely separate field or
- -A physical barrier.

What is your soil type?

Is your ground heavy creating challenges for germination in wet cool seasons? What type of planter do you have?

Planters that use plates do a better job of seed placement with larger kernelled seed. Finger, air, or vacuum planters offer the ability to plant any size or shape seed with great accuracy.

Do you have refrigeration or a cooler?

NATURAL SWEET XR F1

All corn keeps without refrigeration for at least one day but as time progresses the corn continues to respire and the sugars convert to starches, so the corn loses it sweetness. Refrigeration slows this conversion process down thus extending the shelf life.

Know your market...what are your customers looking for? If you're not sure try several different types and offer tastings or give away ears with the request for feedback. As time progresses the market continues to shift toward bi-color and high quality Supersweets. This is the type of corn your customers are buying in the winter or off season so they will expect the same high quality in season.

Confused by all the nomenclature? Let's try to simplify it:

su aka Standard

Traditional varieties that started the sweet corn revolution; these have been on the market for years. They taste best when eaten within hours of picking. Less sugar per kernel with very limited storability. Larger sized seed for good emergence under tough conditions. Isolation required for kernel color but not taste. Sold by weight. Example: Silver Queen.

se aka Sugar Enhanced and sy aka Synergistic

The next generation after su for an increase in sugars with the benefit of the traditional corn flavor, often very creamy in texture. Breeders have enhanced the se class with additional sugary kernels and created a new class, sy Synergistic. These varieties are branded as Synergistic, Augmented, Triple Sweet and Synergistic Plus. They taste best when eaten within 2 days of picking. Medium sized seed with generally good emergence in tough conditions. Isolation is required for kernel color but not for taste however sugars are enhanced if isolated. Sold by seed count or Ms. Se example: Temptation, sy example: Allure.

sh2 aka Supersweet and shA aka Augmented Supersweet

Leaps above se for sugars. These varieties have the ability to hold in the field for several days as well as hold in cold storage for an extended period of time because the sugars convert to starches very slowly. Breeders have branded these enhancements in sugars and tenderness of pericarp with names like Xtra-Tender, Reserve, Augmented and Augmented HQ. Isolation is required for kernel color and taste. If these are not isolated from all other corn types the sugars will revert to starch and produce an ear similar in taste to field corn. Increased sugars in the kernels perpetuate smaller seed size or higher seed counts per pound. Sold by seed count or Ms. sh2 example: Mirai, shA example: Epiphany.















