






## Before Installation


- 1. Please read these instructions before assembling or installing the product.
- NOTE: Installation by a licensed electrian is recommended.

  2. Take out the fixture and the mounting package and make sure all parts are included. If any part is missing or damaged, please contact us.
- 3.All parts must be used as indicated in theseinstructions. Do not substitute any
- parts, leave parts out, or use any parts that are worn out or broken.

  4. Do not disassemble the main body, as it has been installed & commissioned correctly &
- 5. IMPORTANT: Turn off the main power at the circuit breaker and place the wall switch or pull
- 6. Do not use bulbs with wattage greater than specified on this fixture.

- 1 Hanging plate locks wall with suction top plate fixed A B
- 2 Wire lock wire buckle Connection hardware roundabout with hardware lock C D
- $3~\mathrm{E27}$  lamp cap is locked on the aluminum parts of the outer teeth of the car and the iron parts are locked F G
- 4 The notched aluminum piece is placed in the glass ball and locked with the aluminum parts of the interior teeth
- 5 Put the rotating button of the glass ball on the aluminum parts of the outer teeth
