

## **Care and Maintenance Advice**

Thank you for Purchasing a Charlotte Edwards painted bath. We hope you enjoy it for many years to come.

Our Painted baths are Bespoke and painted to order, this means they need a little bit more love and attention to maintain the condition of the paint

- Once the last coat is applied it can take a further 2 weeks before the surface is at its maximum strength/scratch resistance, so please be careful with how the bath is moved and avoid any sharp objects touching the paint
- For baths with a rolling or flat lip we apply a thin line of lacquer around the edge of the paint to help seal and protect it
  - \* for longevity of the bath we recommend re-applying the lacquer line every 6 months, please contact us at <a href="mailto:info@charlotte-edwards.co.uk">info@charlotte-edwards.co.uk</a> for any help and tips
- For both the inside and outside of the bath please avoid using any harsh chemicals or bleach, wiping with warm soapy water is sufficient
- Excessive friction can cause damage, please do not scrub aggressively
- We have supplied a tube of top up paint in the colour of the bath purchased, please inspect the bath upon arrival and once installed.

If any scratches have occurred please dab and wipe a small amount of paint on the affected area, it's best to build in layers so please repeat the process giving time for the paint to dry between coats.
