Tissino Baths - Maintenance and care instructions

Acrylic baths

Only clean the surface with a soft cloth and soapy water. Do not use abrasive cleaning liquids. More resistant stains can also be removed with warm water and a mild, liquid detergent or soap sud. Using cleaning substances other than recommended, can cause damage the product.

Solid surface baths

Under normal use, the solid surface will retain its beauty with only a minimal amount of care. To maintain the elegant look follow these simple steps:

- Use common household, non-abrasive cleaners.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners as they will scratch the surface.
- If the product feels gritty when rubbed between your fingers, do not use.
- Rinse well and dry with a soft, clean cloth.
- Do not allow the surface to come into contact with nail polish, nail polish remover, dry cleaning solution, lacquer thinners, gasoline, pine oil, etc.
- Remove dust and dry dirt with a soft, damp cloth.
- Clean grease, oil, paint, or ink stains with isopropyl (rubbing) alcohol.
- Dry with a clean, soft cloth.
- Avoid using razor blades or other sharp objects that might scratch the surface.
- Most minor scratches can be removed by sanding the area with #320 dry sandpaper.
- Construction debris can be removed with a mild detergent.
