1.1 What is hearing loss?

A speech frequency puretone average (average of hearing thresholds at 0.5, 1, 2, and 4 kHz) of greater than 25 dB hearing level (HL) in both ears was defined as hearing loss per World Health Organization criteria, and this is the level at which hearing loss begins to impair communication in daily life. (Extracted from the literature of: World Health Organization prevention of Blindness and deafness(PBD) program. Prevention of Deafness and Hearing Impaired Grades of Hearing Impairment)

1.2 What's hearing aid?

This hearing aid was used the air-conduction type to compensate of impaired hearing. It is a wear sound-amplifying device. The fundamental operat-

ing principle of hearing aid is to receive, amplify, and transfer sound to the ear drum of a hearing impaired person.

II. INTENDED USE

- 2.1 Medical purpose
 The hearing aid was intended to compensate of impaired hearing.
- 2.2 Intended patients and environment The hearing aid expect used indoor and outdoor environment, any patients if need hearing compensated decided by doctor can be using but the patients must over than 36 months old.
- 2.3 Side effects
 - For the patients skin sensitive with silicon material, may be caused the ear canal pruritus.

 First use may cause ear canal appear temporary maladjustment, such as slight pain.

- Don't use it at high volume for long time. Otherwise it will injure your ear. If you feel uncomfortable, please stop using.
- Please maintain the products time to time, avoid ear plug and sound collecting hole being blocked by foreign objects. It will affect the effect of sound amplifier.
- Avoid shocking or throwing the product. Don't keep or use it in environment of humid high temperature (such as sauna room).

- Don't throw the scrapped battery as common rubbish, it should be handled by special equipment.
- Don't use the product in potential explosive or dangerous environment.
- Don't use in an oxygen rich environment, and continue use hearing aid long time
- Do not lend your hearing aid to other persons. Using a hearing aid designed for someone else can result in hearing damage.



How to Use

STEP 1. INSTALLING THE BATTERY

1.Ensure the battery is an A10 Zinc Air battery (one battery included).
2.Open the battery

compartment.

3.Place battery with "+ sign side up.






Note: Ensure that you remove the tag from the battery and let it charge for one minute before inserting the battery into the device.

STEP 2. PLACING AMPLIFIER IN YOUR EAR

1.Start by turning the volume dial to LOW.
2.Move the ON/OFF switch to the ON position.
3.When ready to place the amplifier into your ear, hold the unit by the top section (see figure). Please ensure that your fingers do not cover the microphone as it may cause feedback.





 Carefully place the amplifier device into your ear (see figure).



Note: Make sure you achieve a comfortable fit, and that the microphone is not being blocked. If you hear a beeping sound, make sure the unit fits tightly inside your ear. If necessary, change to a different size ear tip.

STEP 3. ADJUSTING THE VOLUME

To adjust the volume, remove the hearing amplifier and gradually increase the volume by turning the Volume Dial.

STEP 4. AFTER USE

1. To turn off the amplifier, move the OFF position.

The next time you turn on the amplifier, it will have the last volume you selected.


Remove the amplifier from ear, and place it in the case to store.




REPLACING EAR TIPS

VI. MAINTENANCE AND CLEAN

- 6.1Daily maintenance
- It is important to keep your instrument clean and dry. On a daily basis, clean the hearing instruments using a soft cloth or tissue.
- In order to avoid damage due to humidity or excessive perspiration, the use of a drying kit is recommended.
- 6.2Care and maintenance
- Operate the controls with care.
 Do not press hard.

 If the hearing aid is dropped in water, wipe with dry cloth and ask the dispenser for check.

VI.TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	The sound is very weak and vague
Cause	 Battery power isn't enough. If something is wrong with earphone. Is the battery holder closed well?
Remedy	Replace the new battery; Contact your distributor; Close the battery holder well.

Problem	Volume level set too high	
Cause	If the receiver of the hearing aid does not fit the ear properly, or a whistling unpleasant noise may be heard(which is caused by acoustic feedback).	
Remedy	1) Turn the hearing aid off and reposition it properly in the ear. 2) If the receiver does not fit your ear properly, try replacing it with another type. The use of a correctly fitted ear mold is recommended. Please consult your hearing aid dispenser.
