**Emulsifying Ointment** is a semi-opaque waxy ointment, used in the pharmacy as an ingredient in the preparation of Aqueous Cream and Buffered Cream. Emulsifying Ointment contains: Emulsifying wax 30% w/w, white soft paraffin 50% w/w and liquid paraffin 20% w/w.

**How to use Emulsifying Ointment:** Information will be provided with the final preparation.

**Storing Emulsifying Ointment:** Keep out of the sight and reach of children. Store below 25°C. Do not freeze.
