
OUR MISSION

TWB's mission is to provide a comprehensive workforce training and personal development program to help women facing barriers to employment gain self-confidence, transferable workforce skills, and invaluable hands-on experience, which will allow them to find sustainable employment and move toward self-sufficiency.

WHO WE SERVE

TWB serves women facing barriers to employment, including homelessness, involvement with the justice system, recent immigration to the country, domestic violence, behavioral health challenges, and substance abuse issues.

TWB serves low-income women in the Washington, DC metro area.
