Concentrated product. Observe good housekeeping procedures

No vapours present at normal temperatures. Rinse immediately with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Contact a doctor if symptoms persist. Wash thoroughly with soap & water, flush with plenty of water. If irritation persists, seek medical advice.

When assessing action take Risk & Safety Phrases into account.

Use CO₂ Dry Powder or Foam type Extinguishers, spraying extinguishing media to base of flames. Do not use direct water jet on burning material. Avoid vapour inhalation. Keep away from sources of ignition. Do not smoke. Wear positive pressure self-contained breathing apparatus & protective clothing. Closed containers may build up pressure when exposed to heat and should be cooled with water spray.

Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothes. Note that spillages constitute a slipping hazard. Use individual protective equipment (safety glasses, waterproofboots, suitable protective clothing) in case of major spillages.

Keep away from drains, soils, surface and groundwater.

Remove all potential ignition sources. Contain spilled material. Cover with an inert or non-combustible inorganic absorbent material, sweep up and remove to an approved disposal container. Clean with hot water and detergents. Observe state, federal and local disposal regulations.

Apply good manufacturing practice & industrial hygiene practices. Observe good personal hygiene, and do not eat, drink or smoke whilst handling. Avoid static discharges.

Store in tightly closed original container, in a cool & dry area away from heat sources & protected from light. Keep air contact to a minimum

Keep away from ignition sources & naked flames. Take precautions to avoid static discharges in working area.
