This suite of five Verdure tapestries were brought to Wolterton Hall by Horatio Walpole in the mid-18th century. Whilst the origin of the suite is unknown, it is likely to be of either Soho or Antwerp tapestry weavers. Depicting the mythological love story of Venus and Adonis, the suite portrays the Goddess's attempts to seduce a handsome but reluctant young man, an illustrious narrative made famous by William Shakespeare in his 1593 poem of the same name.
