

- Unplug the power cord after each use.

- 5 Do not pull on the electrical cord.

- 6 Do not plug in while folded for storage.
- 7 Staying too long in the sauna can cause overheating. It is recommended not to use the sauna for over 30 minutes per day and not more than 3 times per week.
- 8 Not recommended for use by anyone under 18 years of age.
- Do not use the sauna under any of the following health conditions: Any type of respiratory condition. Anyone with a heart condition. High or low blood pressure. Pregnancy. Any skin disease or disorders. After or during drinking alcohol or alcoholic beverages.

#### **Handling Precautions:**

Hyperthermia occurs when the internal temperature of the body reaches a level several degrees above the normal body temperature of 98.6°F (37°C). Symptoms include an increase in internal body temperature, dizziness, lethargy, drowsiness, and fainting.

#### Cleaning and Maintenance:

- 1 Unplug the power cord after each use.
- After use, always wipe down the inside cover with a dry cloth; never put the sauna away while it is damp.

#### **Power Supply:**

Use the main power supply of 220V-240V. Only use original cables for the sauna box, and ensure you use a GFCI outlet for the Steam generator's power cord.

#### **Safety Precautions:**

- One-piece stretch-formed stainless steel liner
- Anti-dry, explosion-proof, anti-leakage
- Water shortage "Drip" alarm
- The inner liner is thick and not easy to rupture
- High power heating, 9-speed adjustment

When the product is removed from the package, the cover is buckled on the machine's inner casing. Please overturn the bottom of the machine, then you can take it off with your hand on the lid. Accessories such as kits and remote controls are generally placed in the liner; please do not twist the screws on the grid. Also, do not remove the grid (the left cover is a schematic for reference only. Please, subject to the actual object). The grid is used to block debris from plugging out the steam hole.



#### **Warning Statements:**

- It means the cover is tightened (the cover is twisted in the end, the white groove is completely exposed).
- The raised round hat is a pressure relief valve (explosion-proof), it is a kind of security measure.
- Please tighten the cover in the direction of the arrow.
- Please do not unscrew the cover while the machine is working to prevent steam burns.
- Please do not connect non-temperature-resistant tubes to avoid unnecessary trouble.





Upon Receiving the Product:

#### Pill Box Analysis:

The pill box is used for placing essential oils, so the box can be opened.

- The top cover of the pill box.
- The bottom case of the pill box.
- 3 The medicine package of the compartment.



The essential oil must be placed on the compartment; do not put on the bottom to avoid affecting the steaming tablets. Flakes need to be placed in the grid and then tightened.

(The hole in the bottom of the kit is designed because the water vapor will form condensation when it is condensed into water, and the water will affect the steam hole.




Ensure you have all the metal tubes components listed


- A Tube \* 8 pcs






Lay out all parts in an organized manner for easy access.

Assemble the Bottom Structure


Follow the diagram below when connecting the tubes to create the bottom structure.



(Note: Repeat this process for the top structure, as it has the same build.)

The top and bottom structures are interchangeable, meaning you can use the same assembly process for both.




#### Assemble the Side Structure:

Connect all B tubes and C tubes vertically, starting with a B followed by 2 Cs connected under. This will be used on the 5 corners of the sauna. Also, make sure the C tubes are facing downwards so the B tube connects. Once the side structure parts are complete, place it on a flat surface.









Phase 2

Attaching the Sauna Tent

#### Step 1

- Carefully place the frame structure created into the sauna tent floor. Ensure that the tent aligns with every corner of the frame structure.
- Remember to add the sauna mat before after placing frame structure, ensuring it is properly aligned fitting to every corner.





2 Lift the cover to the top as shown in the diagram below.



Now use the fold of the sauna tent to fit to all top frames accordingly, as the images show.



After doing this, now all that remains is zipping the sauna tent to complete the assembly.




Phase 3

#### Step 1

Now that the tent is complete, it's time to connect the steam generator to the sauna. First, use the shorter semi-transparent hose and connect it to the pillbox as shown below. Once this is done, place it inside the sauna tent.






Next, make use of the white male connectors and attach them to the other end of the hose. The hose will now go halfway through the small hole at the side of the sauna, coming through the outside of the sauna.





Use the female connector to now screw the male connector, which is already fitted in the sauna from outside, ensuring it looks like this.



Now connect the second longer semi-transparent hose from the male connector to the steam generator, as seen below.







## Fill the Generator Compartment:


Add water to the generator compartment up to the maximum water level indicator.

## Secure the Lid:


Tighten the lid clockwise to prevent steam from escaping




#### Using the Steam Generator

Plug the steam generator into the correct home outlet 110v, switch on the power, and press "ON/OFF."






#### Using the Steam Generator

Place the foldable chair inside the sauna.





0	If using a remote control, ensure the CR2025/2032 button battery is properly loaded.
Auto	omatic Stop Feature:
2	The generator stops automatically if the water dries out. After cooling down, restart if needed.
Maiı	ntenance Tips:
3	Avoid adding corrosive liquids to the pot for an extended lifespan.
4	After use, wipe the interior with a soft towel to remove water.
Herb	os Usage:
5	If using herbs, place them in a non-woven fabric bag. Inside white pill box.

#### Using the Steam Generator

#### **Remote Control Guide:**

- A Switch Button (A): Press this button to switch between standby and operating status.
- Timing Minus Button (C): Shorten time.
- B Timing Plus Button (B): Prolong time.
- Performance Down Button (D): Decrease performance level.
- Performance Up Button (E): Enhance performance level.



#### Regular use of the Sauna

It is recommended not to use the sauna for over 30 minutes per day.

#### How to clean Sauna

- 1 To clean and store, open the zipper to ventilate and cool.
- After each use, remove condensation or perspiration from the interior with a clean, damp cloth.
- 3 Do not use harsh cleaning agents.
- 4 Unplug the generator when not in use and fold for storage.
