Yoke

CO 29 (31, 33, 35, 41, 43) sts.

Set-up row place markers for raglan inc: (WS) P2, pm, p5 (5, 5, 5, 7, 7), pm, p15 (17, 19, 21, 23, 25), pm, p5 (5, 5, 5, 7, 7), pm, p2.

Note: Before beginning the next section, read through instructions to the separation of body and sleeves. Raglan shaping, neck shaping, and buttonhole rows are worked at the same time and buttonhole rows continue after separation of body and sleeves.

Begin raglan shaping

Row 1 raglan inc row: (RS) *Knit to 1 st before m, m1, k1, sl m, k1, m1; rep from * 3 more times, knit to end (8 sts increased)—37 (39, 41, 43, 49, 51) sts.

Row 2: Purl.

Begin neck shaping

Row 3 neck and raglan inc row: (RS) K1, m1, *knit to 1 st before m, m1, k1, sl m, k1, m1; rep from * 3 more times, knit to last st, m1, k1 (10 sts increased)—47 (49, 51, 53, 59, 61) sts.

Row 4: Purl.

Cont working *neck and raglan inc row* every RS row 3 (3, 3, 3, 4) more times, ending on a RS row—77 (79, 81, 83, 89, 101) sts.

Next row cast on for neck: (WS) Using the backwards loop cast on, CO 5 (6, 6, 7, 8, 8) sts, then purl to end. Next row: (RS) CO 5 (6, 6, 7, 8, 8) sts, then work raglan inc row to end—95 (99, 101, 105, 113, 125) sts.

Next row: CO 5 (6, 7, 8, 8, 9) sts, purl to end.

Next row: CO 5 (6, 7, 8, 8, 9) sts, then work raglan inc row to end—113 (119, 123, 129, 137, 151) sts.

Next row: Purl.

Cont working raglan inc row as est 5 (5, 5, 5, 6, 4) times, ending on a WS row, pc meas approx 3 (3, 3, 3, 3¼, 3¼)" from original CO edge -153 (159, 163, 169, 185, 183) sts.

Begin buttonholes

Note: Buttonholes extend beyond raglan shaping. Next row buttonhole row: (RS) Work raglan inc row as est to last 14 (16, 16, 18, 18, 20) sts, work 2-st buttonhole, knit 8 (10, 10, 12, 12, 14) sts, work 2-st buttonhole, k2.

Next row: Purl.

Cont in St st and work raglan inc row every RS row 2 (4, 4, 5, 6, 9) times, then every other RS row 0 (0, 1, 2, 1, 1) times—177 (199, 211, 233, 249, 271) sts. And, at the same time, rep buttonhole row every 8th (10th, 12th, 14th, 12th, 14th) row 3 (3, 3, 3, 4, 4) times more, for a total of 4 (4, 4, 4, 5, 5) buttonholes

Sizes __ (__, __, __, 261/4, 281/2)" only

Next row sleeve only inc row: (RS) *K to m, sl m, kl,
ml, k to 1 st before m, ml, kl, sl m; rep from * one
more time— __ (__, __, __, 253, 275) sts.

When all neck and raglan shaping is complete: 177
(199, 211, 233, 253, 275) sts on needles [45 (51,
55, 61, 65, 71) back sts, 35 (39, 41, 45, 51, 55)
sleeve sts, and 31 (35, 37, 41, 43, 47) front sts].

If necessary, after all raglan shaping has been completed, work even until pc measures $4\frac{1}{4}$ ($4\frac{3}{4}$, $5\frac{1}{4}$, $5\frac{3}{4}$, $6\frac{1}{4}$, $6\frac{3}{4}$)" from CO edge, end after a WS row.
