Single pattern: Page 3 / column 2

### Pick up in saddle sides and begin neck shaping

**Next row set up short row:** (RS) With larger, shorter circ, RS facing, and beg at end of held front sts, pm for BOR, pick up and knit 13 (15, 17, 16, 17, 15, 17) sts along front side of left saddle, pm, k9 saddle sts, pm, pick up and knit 13 (15, 17, 16, 17, 15, 17) sts along back side of left saddle, place back sts onto LH needle and knit across, pick up and knit 13 (15, 17, 16, 17, 15, 17) sts along back side of right saddle, pm, place right saddle sts onto LH needle and knit across, pm, pick up and knit 13 (15, 17, 16, 17, 15, 17) sts along front side of right saddle, place front sts onto LH needle, but do not knit across, w&t first front st; (WS) sl 1, purl across sts to BOR, w&t first front st—142 (150, 158, 172, 176, 186, 194) sts on needle.

### Under "At the same time"

*When working a sleeve only inc row/rnd:* \*Work to m, sl m, **k1**, k1-f/b, knit to 2 sts before next m, k1-f/b, k1, sl m; rep from \* one more time, work to end (4 sts inc'd, on sleeves only).
