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Under "needles"

US 7 / 4.5 mm

- 32" / 80 cm circular needle
- **set of double-pointed needles**

US 5 / 3.75 mm

- 32" / 80 cm circular needle
- **set of double-pointed needles**

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Under "sleeves"

Using **smaller dpns** and a long-tail cast on, CO 40 (42, 42, 44, 44)[46, 46, 48, 48] sts. **Join in the round, dividing evenly among dpns.**

RIBBING SETUP **RND**: (K1, p1) repeat to end.

Cont in ribbing as est for 16 **rnds** more.

Switch to **larger dpns**.

NEXT **RND**: K1, work in Moss St to last st, k1.

INC **RND**: K1, M1L, work in Moss St to last st, M1R, k1.
2 sts inc.

Rep this inc **rnd** every 30 (20, 12, 8, 6)[4, 4, 4, 2] **rnds**

2 (5, 6, 7, 8)[3, 14, 23, 6] times more, then every - (-, 14, 10, 8)[6, 6, -, 4] **rnds** 0 (0, 2, 4, 6)[14, 6, 0, 20] times more. 46 (54, 60, 68, 74)[82, 88, 96, 102] sts.

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Break yarn, leaving a tail 8–10" / 20–25 cm long. Set aside and repeat instructions for second sleeve.

Sew sleeve seams using Mattress Stitch.
