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Under "Begin lace motifs"

Note: First repeat of Row 1 of Hafting and Double Hafting lace motifs make a transition between brioche and lace. Follow the instructions as written below for the first row of the first repeat, then work Row 1 as written in the stitch pattern instructions on subsequent repeats.

Next row: (RS) K1, sl1yo, sl m, work Row 1 of Brioche Bract motif, sl m, sl1yo, (yo, brssk) two times, brk, (brk2tog, yo) two times, sl1yo, sl m, work Row 1 of Brioche Bract motif, sl m, sl1yo, (yo, brssk) two times, brk, (brk2tog, yo) two times, k1, (yo, brssk) two times, brk, (brk2tog, yo) two times, sl1yo, sl m, work Row 1 of Brioche Bract motif, sl m, sl1yo, (yo, brssk) two times, brk, (brk2tog, yo) two times, sl1yo, sl m, work Row 1 of Brioche Bract motif, sl m, sl1yo, k1-tbl.

Next row: Sl 1, brk, sl m, work Row 2 of Brioche Bract motif, sl m, work Row 2 of Hafting Lace motif, sl m, work Row 2 of Brioche Bract motif, sl m, work Row 2 of Double Hafting Lace motif, sl m, work Row 2 of Brioche Bract motif, sl m, work Row 2 of Hafting Lace motif, sl m, work Row 2 of Brioche Bract motif, sl m, brk, sl 1.

Next row: K1, sl1yo, sl m, work next row of Brioche Bract motif, sl m, work next row of Hafting Lace motif, sl m, work next row of Brioche Bract motif, sl m, work next row of Double Hafting Lace motif, sl m, work next row of Brioche Bract motif, sl m, work next row of Hafting Lace motif, sl m, work next row of Brioche Bract motif, sl m, sl1yo, k1-tbl.

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The odd numbered rows of all three charts have **incorrect symbols for the brk and sl1yo stitches** (the chart shows a symbol for the opposite stitch from what is needed). All non-brk and non-sl1yo stitches are correct in those odd rows and the even rows are all fine.
